- (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, and 18

- 20 Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, for the fiscal year
- beginning July 1, 2025, and for the payment of bills incurred 21

- 3 Section 2. The sum of \$550,000 is appropriated from the
- 4 restricted revenue account within the Workmen's Compensation
- 5 Administration Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate in
- 6 the Department of Community and Economic Development as provided
- 7 in the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the
- 8 Workers' Compensation Act, for the operation of that office for
- 9 the fiscal year July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025, or
- 11 immediately, whichever is later.
