

The following restricted revenue account is being established in the General Fund for the Department of Health to record funds received from the settlement agreement between the Commonwealth and JUUL Labs, Inc. (JLI).

Section 1507.1 of the Fiscal Code, 72 P.S. § 1507.1, provides that settlements must be deposited in the General Fund and acknowledges that the Commonwealth must expend settlements in accordance with court orders. The court order stipulates that monies from the JUUL settlement must be used by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Bureau of Health Promotion and Risk Reduction, to reduce or eliminate tobacco-related death and disease in the Commonwealth by: promoting smoke-free environments and tobacco-free lifestyles; developing and implementing strategic and culturally appropriate efforts to reduce tobacco product use and exposure to secondhand smoke; preventing youth and young adults from starting to use tobacco products; promoting tobacco use cessation among youth and adults; eliminating exposure to secondhand smoke; identifying and eliminating tobacco-related disparities; and other similar activities.
