SUMMARY: HB 105 Amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to exempt certain veterans from vehicle registration fees.

ANALYSIS: HB 105 exempts certain veterans from title and registration fees. These are veterans who lost a limb or eye or who became partially paralyzed while serving, those captured by the enemy during conflicts for which the Department of Defense authorizes a campaign medal, and those who have been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor or the Purple Heart.

This bill also repeals language related to these individuals being charged a processing fee in lieu of registration fee.

This legislation will take effect in five months.

FISCAL IMPACT: IT system update costs have been estimated at \$1.5 million. Lost title and registration fees for enactment of this legislation would be less than \$250 thousand annually.
