



Top 10 Questions Asked at...

Harrisburg CCC

1. What am I allowed to have?

Reentrants are provided a copy of the property list. Anything not included on the list is not allowed.

2. Do we feed our reentrants?

HCCC does not provide food for reentrants. Upon a reentrant's arrival, a COMPASS Application for SNAP Benefits is completed and benefits are usually available the next business day.

3. What are some possible home plan options?

Reentrants will work with their parole agent and counselor to submit a home plan in Pennsylvania or for another state if the reentrants would like to live in another state. However, interstate home plans take much longer to process.

4. Is there a black out time period?

There is no black out period. Reentrants must attend orientation on Friday morning no exceptions.

5. How do you help with housing?

The center provides referrals for housing assistance.

6. How do I get to where I need to go?

The center will assist reentrants by printing out directions from online to various locations, go to the bus station for bus routes, and are given a map of Harrisburg.

7. How long do I have to stay?

For parolees, you must stay until your home plan is approved. For SIP participants, you must stay until your furlough address is approved and you will report a minimum of one time per week until reentrant completes their sentence.

8. What are the privileges?

The planners will be reviewed with reentrants during orientation.

9. Is there a curfew?

8 pm for full-time workers. 7 pm for non-full-time workers.

10. Do I need to pay rent?

No. You do have to turn in your paystubs to verify your employment.
