


CHC Statewide Enrollments Trends by MCO

#### CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO






#### **CHC Market Share Chart**




# Statewide LTSS Populations Plus HCBS Percentage



#### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In December, the statewide percentage of non-duals increased from 10.0% to 10.2%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs remained the same at 13.0%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs decreased from 36.2% to 35.8%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare increased from 28.1% to 28.3%. Other Medicare Advantage decreased from 10.3% to 10.2%.

#### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan








#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

In December 2023, there were 8,285 participants in CHC who chose to direct their own PAS services and 498 participants in OLTL's FFS programs.


