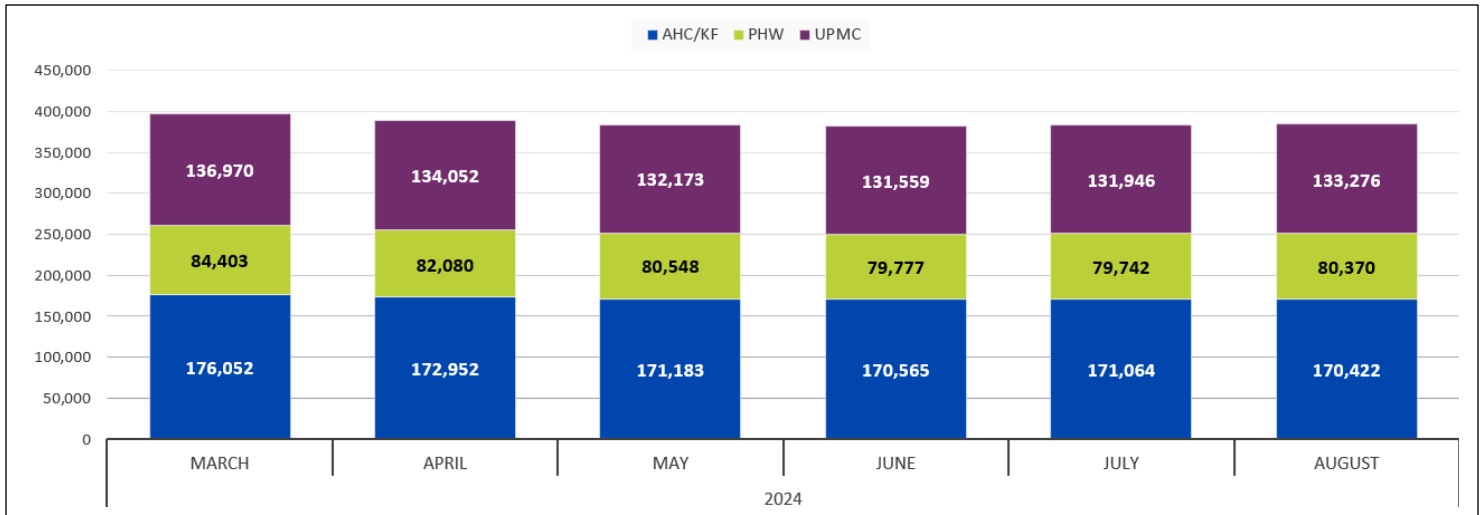

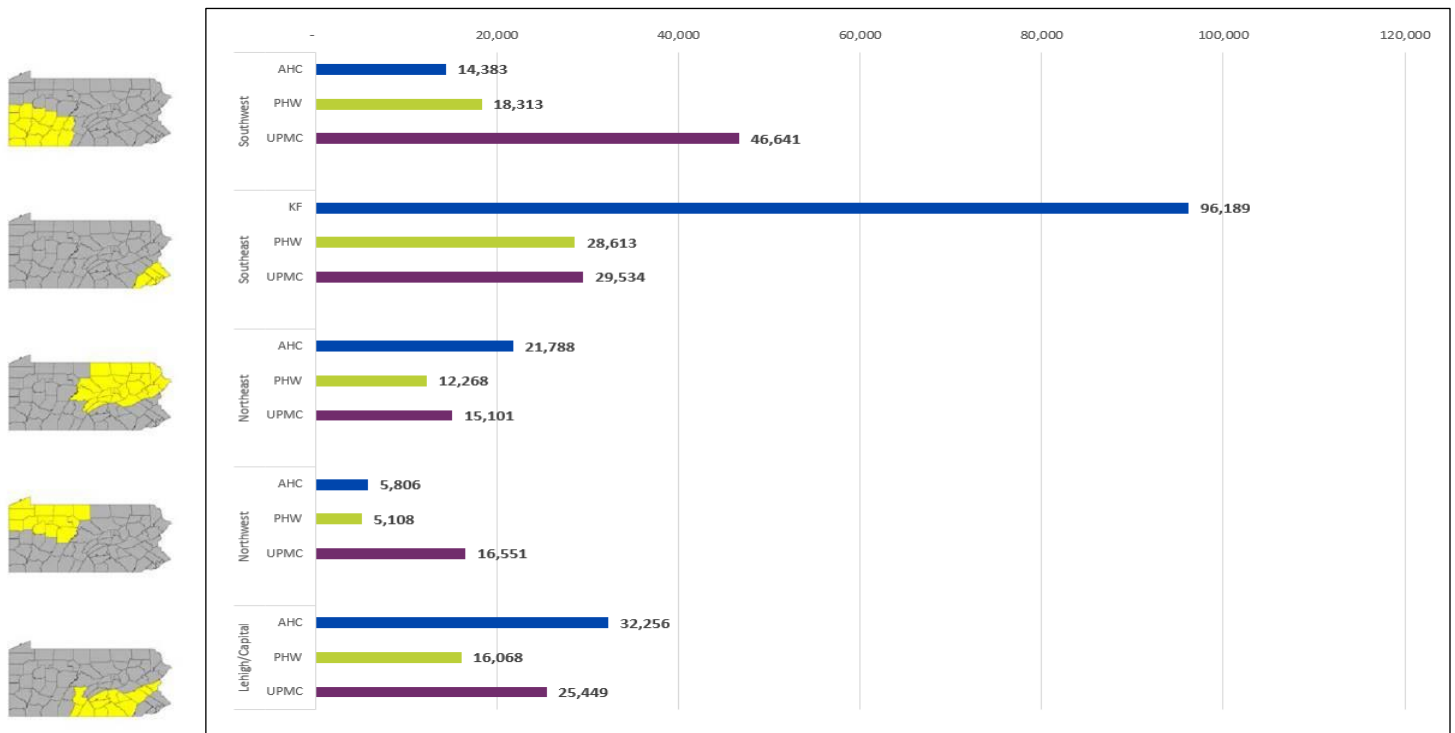
### CHC Statewide Enrollments Trends by MCO

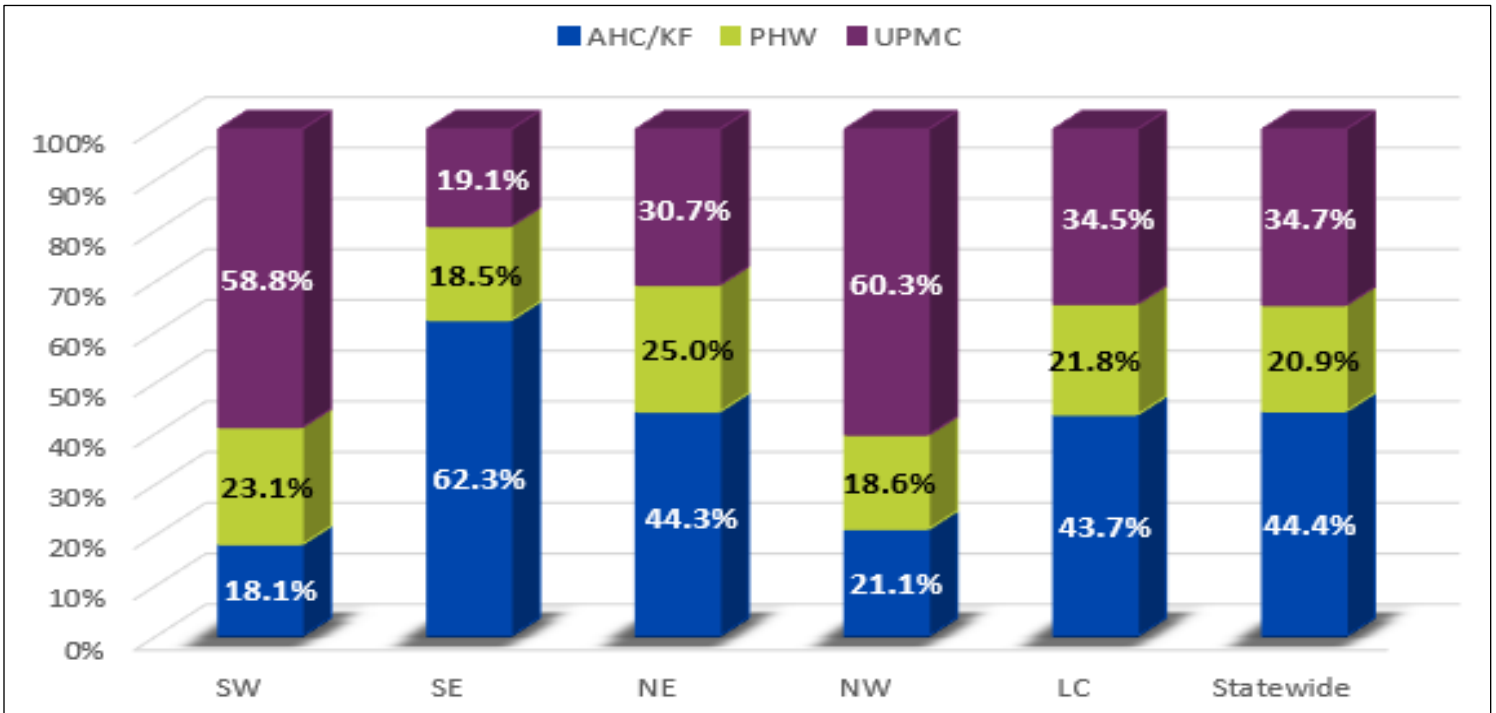
### CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO

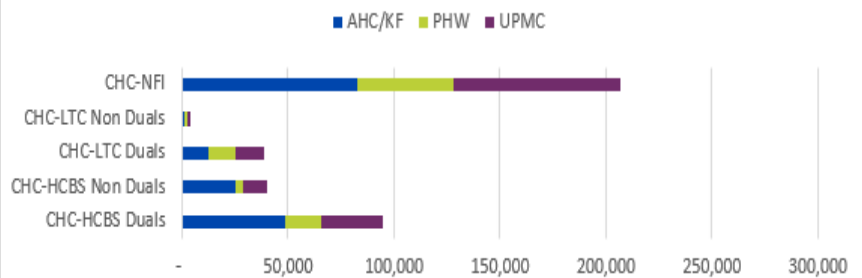

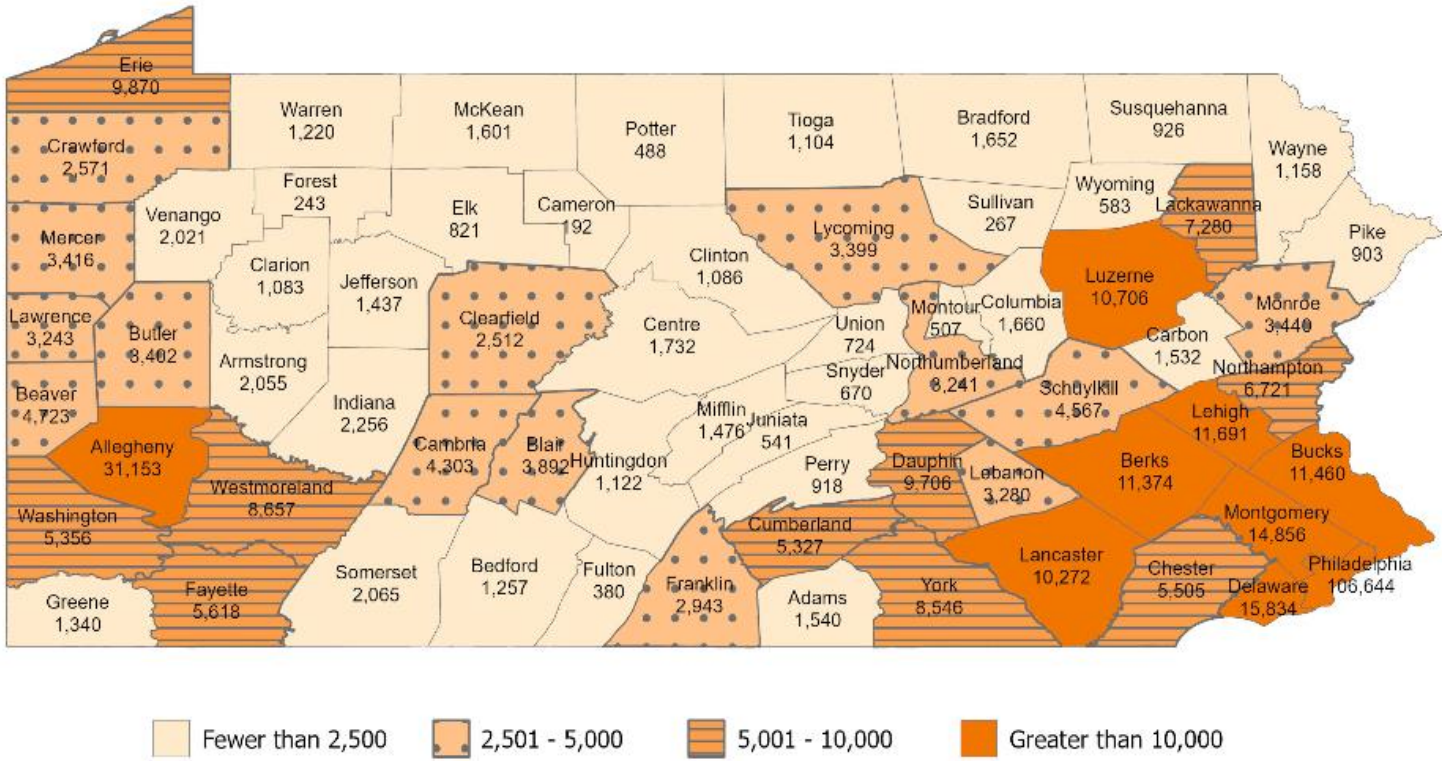

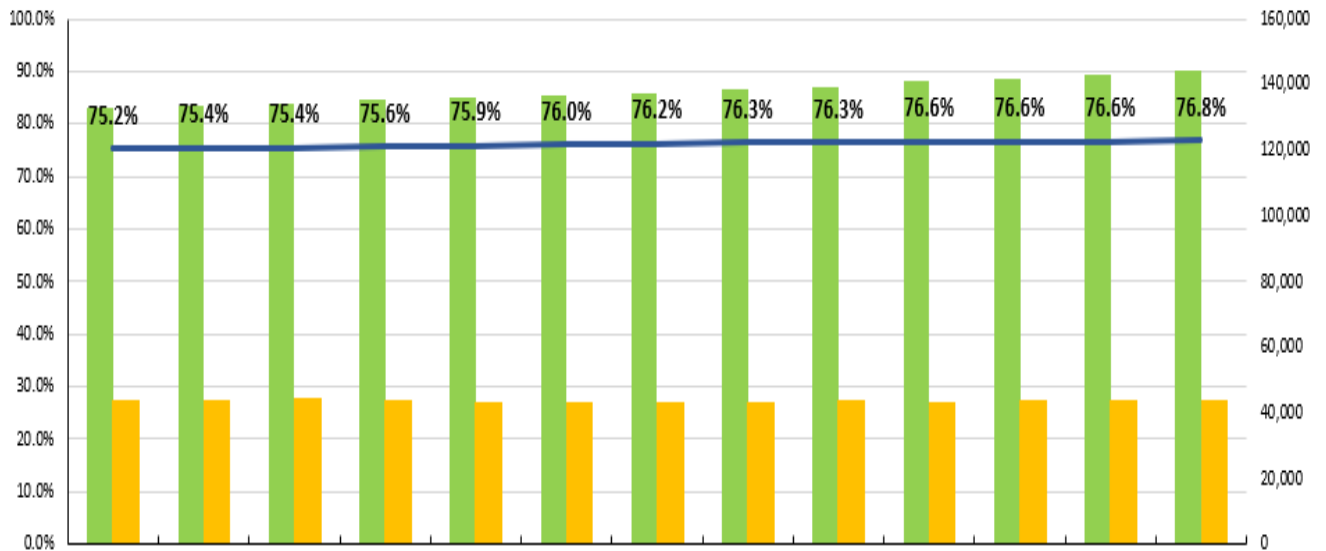

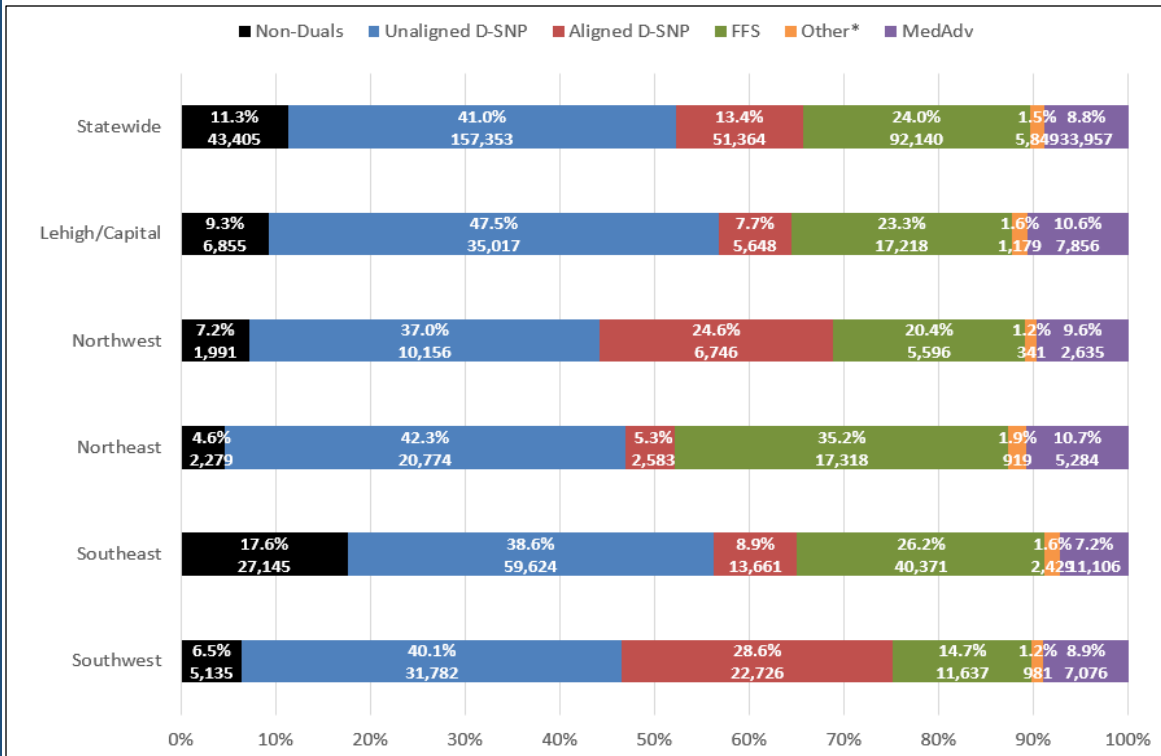

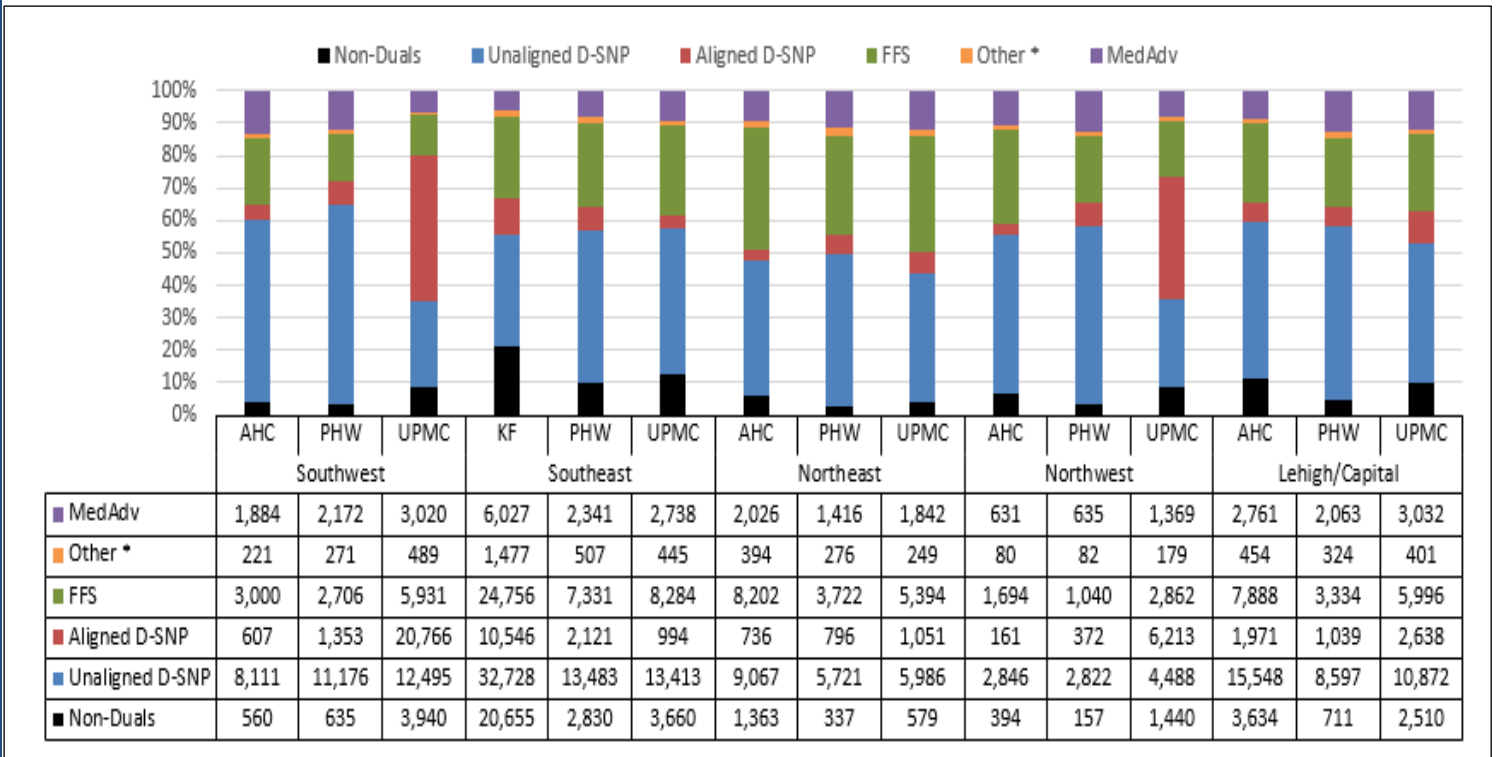
### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In August, the statewide percentage of non-duals increased from 11.2% to 11.3%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs remained the same at 13.4%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 40.7% to 41.0%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased from 24.2% to 24.0%. Other Medicare Advantage decreased from 8.9% to 8.8%.

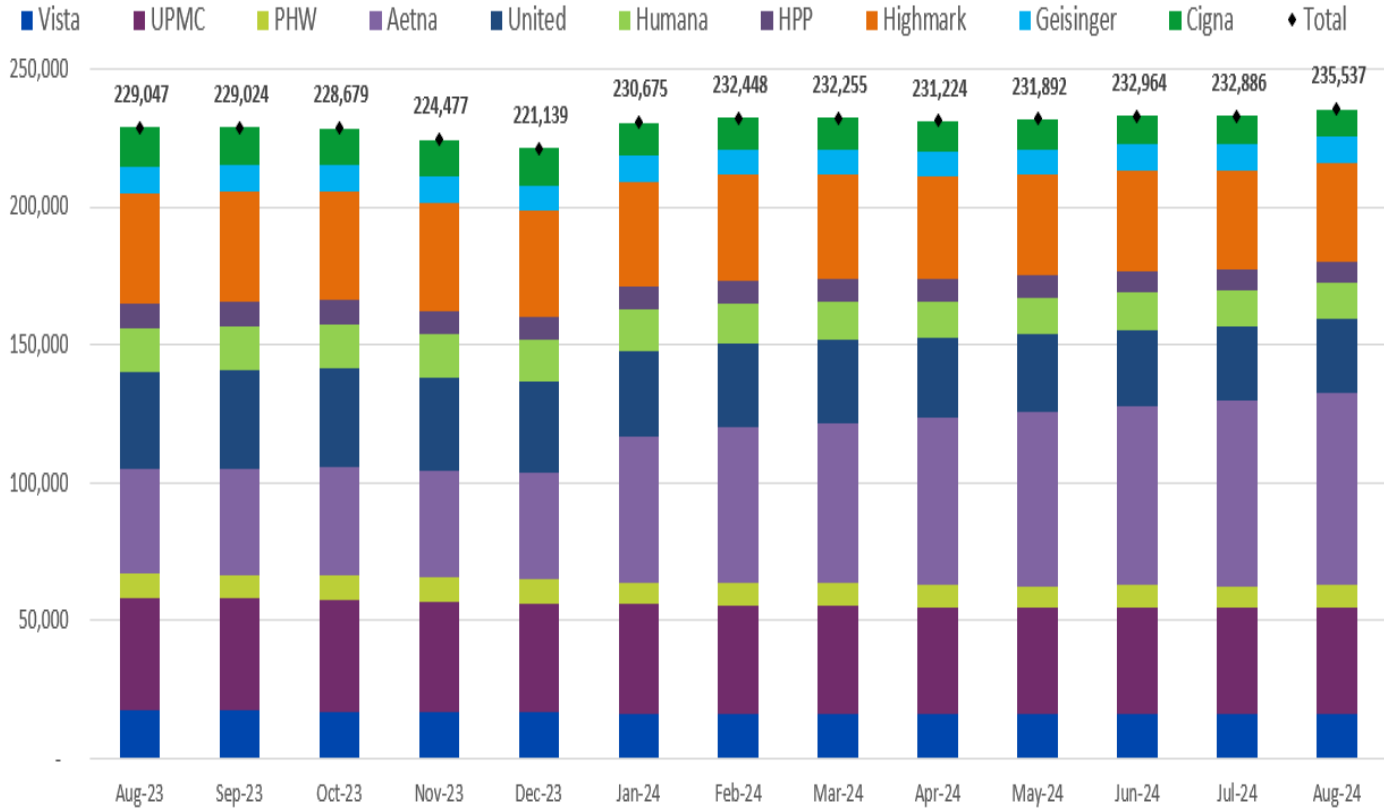
### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan

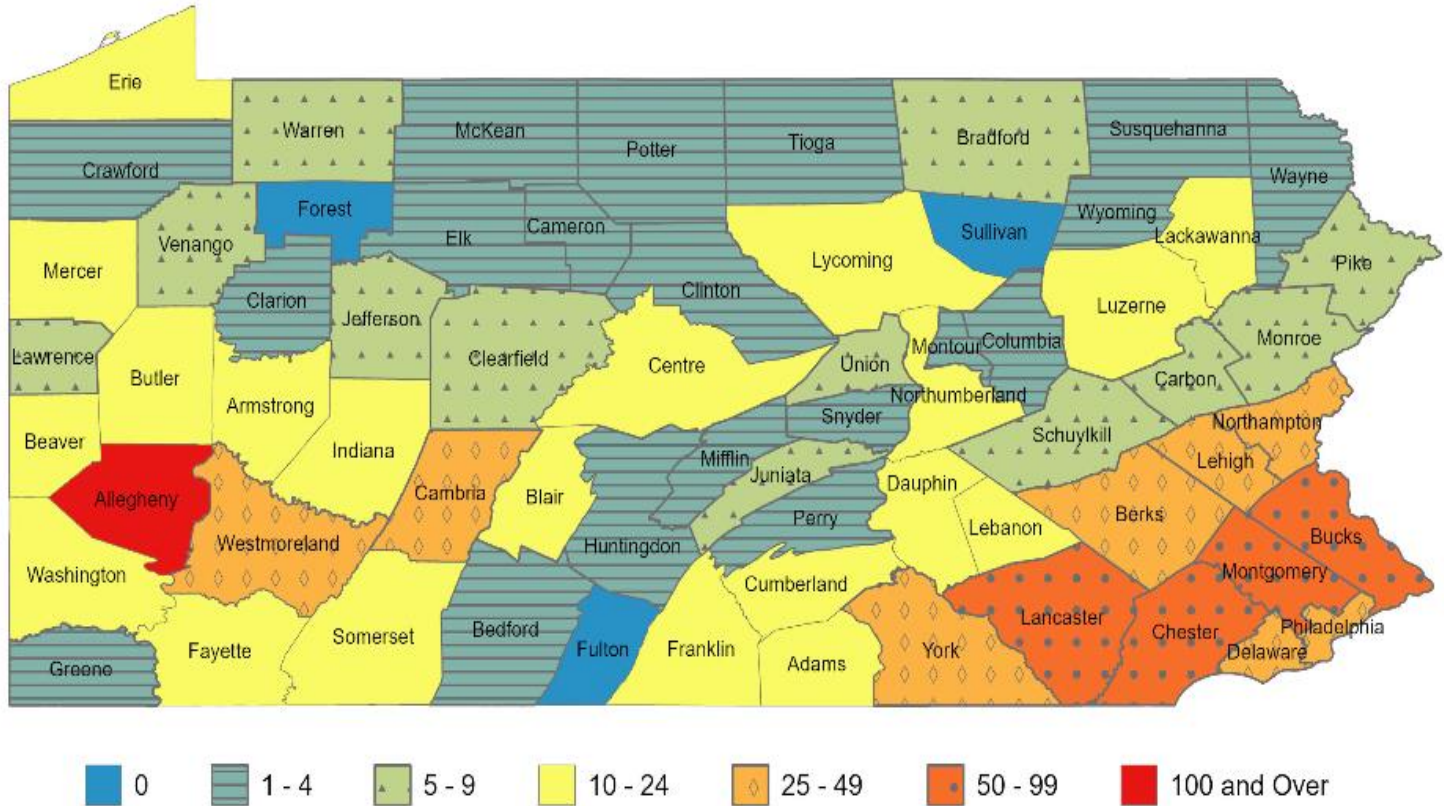

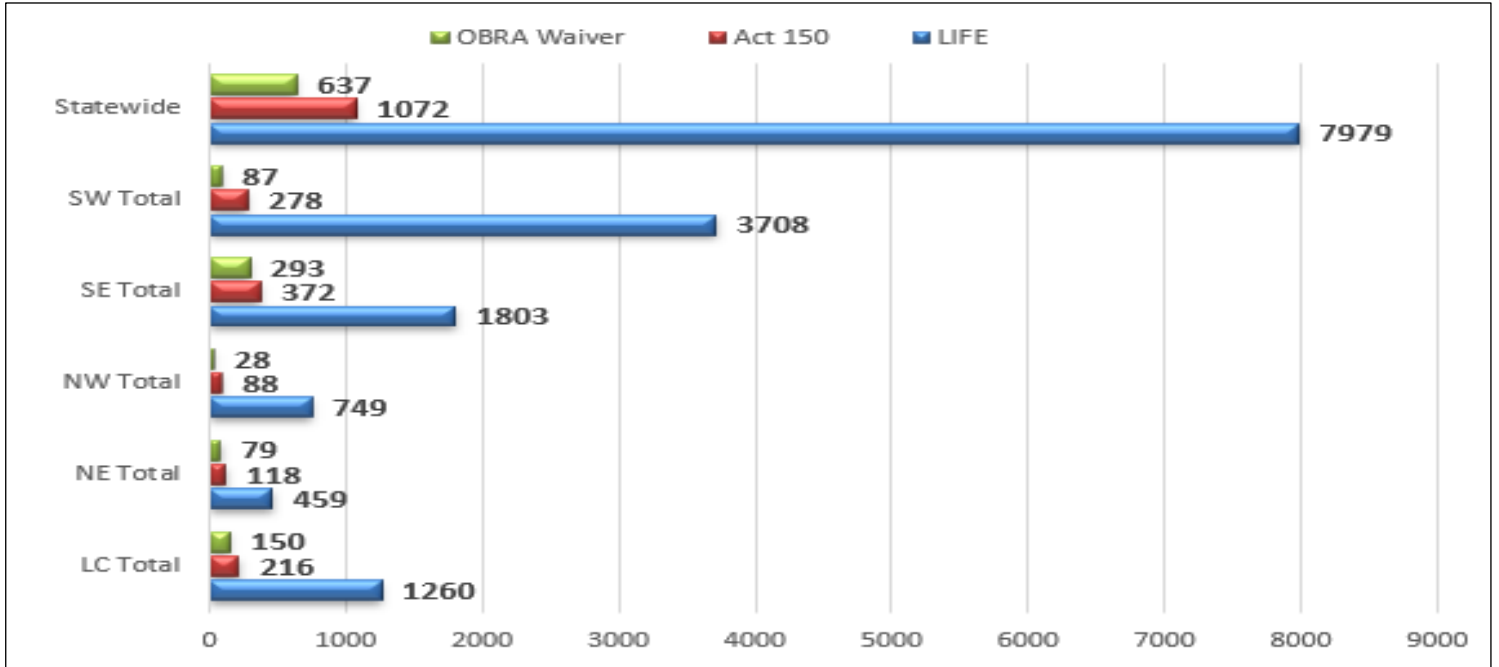

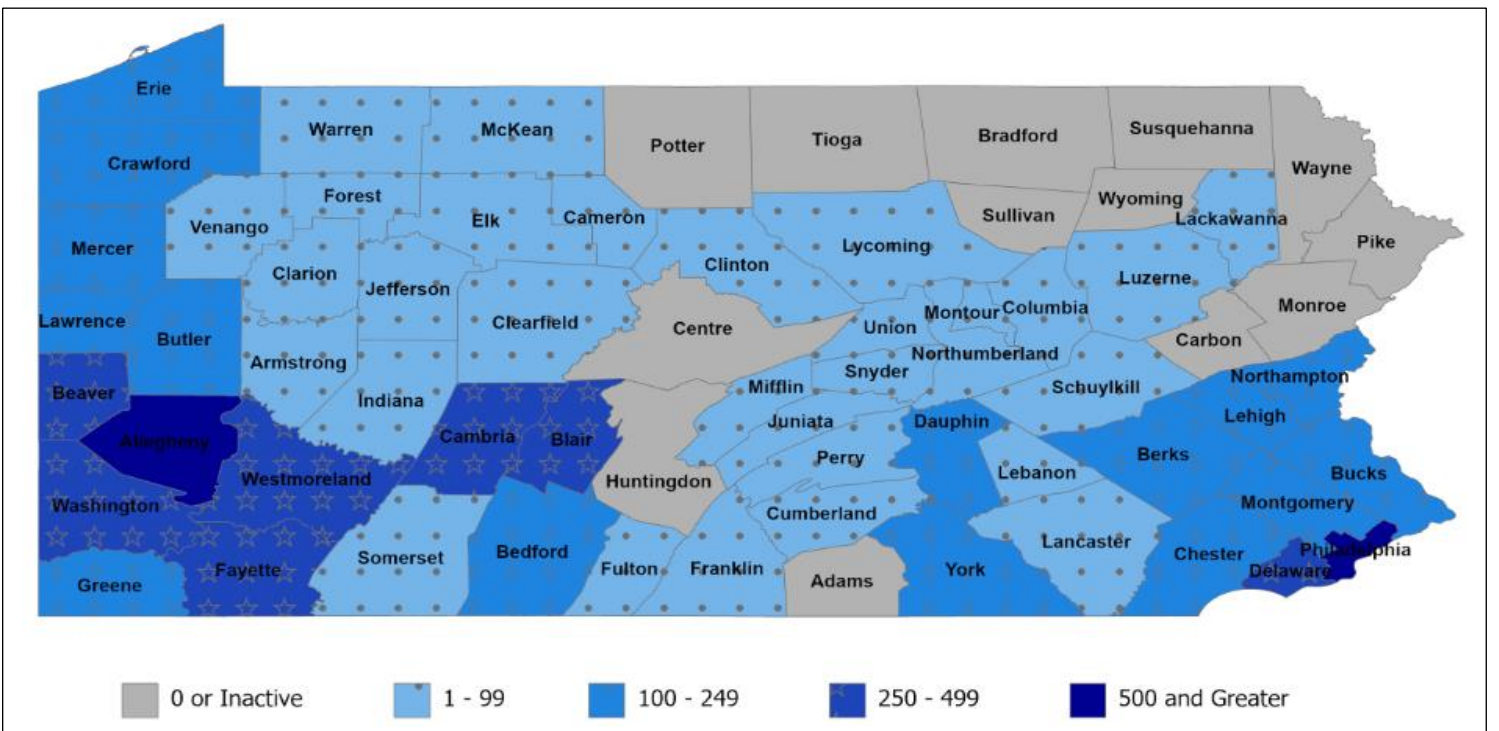
