

Deaf, Hard of Hearing, & Interpreter Resource Collection

The Office for the Deaf & Hard of Hearing (ODHH), the Hiram G. Andrews Center (HGAC), and the Pennsylvania Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (PARID) have collaborated to develop the Deaf, Hard of Hearing, & Interpreter Resource Collection. The collection includes more than 450 items on topics such as hearing loss, deaf culture, coping skills, laws, sign language interpreting, technology, American Sign Language (ASL), and deafblindness.

Items can be borrowed from your local library through the Access PA Interlibrary Loan (ILL) system.

- Select "Hiram G. Andrews Center Library"
- Type your search term in the "find box" (i.e., hard of hearing, deaf, interpreter, ADA)
- If desired, enter additional search criteria in the "Narrow your search to" section
- Search by clicking on the keyword, title, author, subject, or series icon
- Review results
- Make a selection by clicking "add to list"
- Print list
- Take the list to your local library to request items through interlibrary loan (ILL)
