Our Employer Service Center Line provides help on using the <u>UC System</u>, general UC-related questions, eligibility issues, how to complete forms, claimant earning reporting, wage and credit issues.



- **UC System at <u>www.benefits.uc.pa.gov</u>** Assists with login issues, updating contact information and navigating the system.
- Relief from Charges (RFC) Explains the process of filing for RFC via the UC system, (also known as filing a protest from the Employer Charge tab) and provides the status/outcome of RFCs filed, appeals, and other RFC-related questions. Review this guide, Request Relief from Charges. for step-by-step directions.
- Monthly Notice of Compensation Charged (UC-640) Answers questions regarding the process, charges, credits, etc. on the UC-640. Explains how an employer can review the claim in the UC system to determine whether the correct percentage and amount of compensation is correctly charged to the employer's account.
- Power of Attorney (POA) activations, rescinds, and address changes Explains this process and how to use the UC system to make updates to employers and third-party representatives. Review this guide, Employer-TPA Guide, to learn how you can activate your TPA relationship.
- Labor Law Posters The postings required by law should be printed from www.dli.pa.gov. Search for Mandatory Postings. Questions about Workplace Posters, call Labor Law Compliance at 800-932-0665.
- Shared Work program Answers general employer questions pertaining to the Shared Work program.

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- General Questions Claim or Claimant specific UC-related guestions.
- **Eligibility Issues** Questions pertaining to eligibility issues and separations from employment. Examples: discharges, voluntary quits, reasonable assurance, refusal of suitable work, able & available, self-employment, not totally unemployed, etc.
- **Provide Requested Information -** How to complete questionnaires using the UC System or by phone such as Notice of Application (uc-45), fact-finding questionnaires and Post Audit forms (uc-756), etc.
- **Report Earnings** Un-reported or under-reported claimant earnings that are not being properly reported by the employee. (This is a potential claimant overpayment.)
- Financial Determinations Wage and credit week issues as reported on the Financial Determination.
