## New Form, MV-371DV, "Supplemental Application for Free Registration for Veterans"

PennDOT recently created a new form, MV-371DV, "Supplemental Application for Free Registration for Veterans," to allow veteran military customers to apply for free registration for a qualifying car or truck with a registered gross weight of 9,000lb or under. Form MV-371DV, "Supplemental Application for Free Registration for Veterans," edition date is 2-25 and is now available on PennDOT's Driver and Vehicle Services website at <u>www.pa.gov/dmv</u>.

The following individuals are now exempt from title and registration fees for one (1) qualified vehicle:

- Vehicles registered to a veteran who lost a limb or eye or who became partially paralyzed while serving in the armed forces of the United States.
- Vehicles registered to a person who, as a member of the armed forces of the United States, was captured by the enemy in any armed conflict for which the Department of Defense authorizes a campaign medal.
- Vehicles registered to a person who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.
- Vehicles registered to a person who has been awarded the Purple Heart.

Veteran military customers can apply for the free registration regardless of the style of registration plate they currently have to obtain the free registration. Please review Form MV-371DV for all eligibility requirements and general information.

This change is effective immediately.
