Dear Mr. Bowers:

Army regulations require this installation to receive a waiver of safety criteria for all areas of weapon range safety fans which extend beyond installation boundaries. The basis for waiving these areas is the existence of Second Mountain which acts as an excellent back stop. This waiver has traditionally been granted on a calendar year basis.

This headquarters requests that a waiver be granted from 1 Jan 82 through 31 Dec 82 in order to accommodate firing weapon systems as outlined in Incls 1-30. Attached inclosures supersede all previous range fans and are calculated from the most current guidance. Request you purge your file of the old fans and replace them with these new ones.

It remains understood that this waiver must meet the terms and conditions outlined in the 1955 license as amended.
