

Public Statement Regarding the Final Reapportionment Plan for State Legislative Districts 3/16/2022

The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania <u>ordered</u> today that the Final Reapportionment Plan of the Pennsylvania Legislative Reapportionment Commission, filed on Feb. 4, 2022, has the force of law, and shall be used in all forthcoming elections to the General Assembly until the next constitutionally mandated reapportionment is approved.

The Court modified the May 17 General Primary Election Calendar for seats in the General Assembly and for state party committees. The first day to circulate and file nomination petitions will be Friday, March 18, 2022, and the last day to circulate and file nomination petitions will be Monday, March 28, 2022.

Nomination petition forms for candidates will be available on the Department of State website on March 17, 2022.
