14 Regulatory Report - November Regulatory Status Update  
15 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Regulatory Counsel,  
16 provided a Regulatory Status Report for the month of  
17 November for the Board's review.]

18 \*\*\*

19 Regulatory Report - 16A-6923 - Electronic Supervision  
20 and General Revisions

21 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Regulatory Counsel,  
22 addressed 16A-6923 regarding the general revisions  
23 package. She noted finalizing the annex and making  
24 one revision at the Board's request. She referred to  
25 page 8 of the annex under Standards for Supervisors,

1 noting the addition of the phrase "in conjunction  
2 with the supervisee," so the supervisor, in  
3 conjunction with the supervisee, shall establish  
4 objectives to be achieved by the supervisee during  
5 supervision. She also carried that revision to  
6 Chapter 49 page 30.

7 Ms. Wolfgang informed Board members that she is  
8 working on the preamble and is hoping to have that  
9 finalized by the February meeting.

10 Chair Santiago requested an explanation of the  
11 word "reserved."

12 Ms. Wolfgang explained that the section is being  
13 deleted but is reserved so that anyone researching  
14 knows that there was a provision there for procedural  
15 reasons.

16 Chair Santiago referred to page 59 under (6)(i),  
17 where it says the National Certified Counselor  
18 Certification, noting the (CC) should be (NCC).

19 Ms. Wolfgang offered to make that correction.

20 Chair Santiago referred to (6)(vii), the  
21 Certified Clinical Mental Health Counselor (CCMHC)  
22 certification, noting she did not know the  
23 organization, Academy of Certified Clinical Mental  
24 Health Counselors (ACCMHC). She stated the Certified  
25 Clinical Mental Health Counselor designation also

1 comes from the National Board of Certified Counselors  
2 and did not know where the Academy of Certified  
3 Clinical Mental Health Counselors came from. She  
4 further noted that CCMHC comes from NBCC.org.

5 Ms. Wolfgang verified that ACCMHC is inaccurate  
6 and would provide the answer in February as to  
7 whether they can make that change.

8 Chair Santiago referred to (ix), the Certified  
9 Addictions Counselor credential (CAC) and asked  
10 whether the CAC is equivalent to a licensed  
11 professional counselor (LPC). She noted concern that  
12 they have people who do not have master's level  
13 practice certifications serving as supervisors, where  
14 people who do not have certifications at the master's  
15 level but have certifications at the bachelor's level  
16 should not be supervising master's level people  
17 toward licensure.

18 Chair Santiago asked Ms. Wolfgang to look into  
19 whether the CAC credential at the master's level from  
20 the Pennsylvania Certification Board (PCB). She  
21 explained that it should be discussed with the Board  
22 if the answer is no, where they have a non-master's  
23 person supervising master's level clinicians into  
24 practice when every other certification requires a  
25 master's degree.

1           Acting Commissioner Claggett read a comment in  
2 chat stating that Certified Advanced Alcohol and Drug  
3 Counselor is the master's level credential for PCB.

4           Chair Santiago noted the CAC and the CAADC are  
5 not the same thing. She further noted they are  
6 saying the CAADC is the master's level credential and  
7 the Board has it listed as CAC, which is not the  
8 master's level credential. She also noted CAC  
9 actually does not exist on PCB's website, where  
10 something is incorrect at (ix).

11           Ms. Wolfgang explained that it is reserved, so  
12 the Board was deleting the section. She informed  
13 Board members that she would go back and figure out  
14 the rationale because there is no reason to fix it if  
15 it is being deleted. She mentioned that she was not  
16 involved in the original drafting and asked whether  
17 the Board knows why the section was being deleted.

18           Chair Santiago mentioned that there were so many  
19 people outside of professional counseling that people  
20 were being supervised by everybody except for other  
21 professional counselors.]

23 Regulatory Report - 16A-6927 - Associate MFT and  
24 Associate LPC

25 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Regulatory Counsel,

1 noted 16A-6927 regarding associate MFT and LPC has  
2 been finalized. She referred to § 48.13(a) and noted  
3 adding licensed associate marriage and family  
4 therapist (AMFT), subsection (d) notification to the  
5 Board, when an AMFT obtains a new supervisor, the  
6 AMFT shall notify the Board and provide the resume or  
7 curriculum vitae for the licensee or licensees who  
8 provide supervision.

9 Ms. Wolfgang also noted the addition in Chapter  
10 48 and Chapter 49 but did not have any other  
11 substantive changes. She believed the annex is ready  
12 to be sent out as an exposure draft.

13 Chair Santiago referred to related fields for  
14 MFT.

15 Ms. Wolfgang explained that they did not change  
16 the definition and decided to look into opening up a  
17 new regulation to specifically address the related  
18 fields and closely related fields definition. She  
19 mentioned that would be a comprehensive review of all  
20 the chapters and did not want to slow down this  
21 regulation.]
