Members of the General Assembly:

As Secretary of the Commonwealth, I am pleased to report to you on the administration of voter registration in Pennsylvania for calendar year 2005.

In 2005, the Department of State's partnership with county election boards, voter registration commissions, Commonwealth agencies designated with voter registration responsibilities and other groups resulted in the addition of 457,186 voters to the voter registration rolls.

The Department continued its work in administering the agency-based voter registration programs as required under the National Voter Registration Act. This year, that work included collaborating with the Office of Victim Advocate to develop procedures that allow victims of domestic abuse to register and vote while protecting the confidentiality of their home address.

The past year saw the continued implementation of Act 3 of 2002 (Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors – SURE) and the federal Help America Vote Act (HAVA). SURE establishes a statewide voter registration database and requires Pennsylvania's 67 counties to be on the system by January 1, 2006. As of December 27, 2005, all counties were "live" on the system, complying with the federal deadline.

The Department of State is committed to fulfilling its responsibilities under HAVA. This includes promoting voter registration, awareness and outreach activities across the Commonwealth.

The Administration of Voter Registration in Pennsylvania
2005 Report to the General Assembly

In 2005, the Department of State (Department) worked closely with the 67 county voter registration offices, Commonwealth agencies designated with voter registration responsibilities, the public, voter registration advocacy groups and the affected state and local agencies to administer voter registration in Pennsylvania. This report represents a summary of initiatives and statistics that support voter registration administration in Pennsylvania.

Department of Transportation

Since 1995, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has played an integral role in the voter registration process. PennDOT provides Commonwealth citizens with an opportunity to apply to register to vote while receiving or renewing their driver's license at a PennDOT photo license center. In 2005, more than 175,000 individuals applied to register to vote using this resource.

Application Process to Register to Vote at a Photo License Center

- PennDOT customers visit a photo license center with a driver's license application card, provided by PennDOT, which contains a printed two-dimensional bar code. The bar code is scanned, and the computer system determines the customer's age. It then determines which customers will be at least eighteen years old by the date of the next election and asks if the customer wishes to apply to register to vote.
- The program is designed to ask customers if they are already registered to vote. If not, they are provided the opportunity to apply to register.
- Customers can view the qualifications a Pennsylvania citizen must meet to continue with the application.
- Customers who choose to apply for voter registration are asked to confirm their county of residence, indicate a party preference and type their telephone number and race, both of which are optional.
- Customers are advised of the penalty for furnishing false information and are asked to sign a declaration that the information they have provided is true and correct to the best of their knowledge.
- Customers are provided with a receipt indicating pertinent information about their voter registration application, including the date on which they applied at the photo license center. The receipt instructs customers to contact their county voter registration office if they do not receive a voter identification card within two weeks.

The PennDOT computer system stores the completed voter registration applications and transmits the data to Viisage, the contracted vendor. The vendor electronically sorts the applications by county and transmits them electronically to each county voter registration

office. In 2005, the vendor forwarded 188,677 “motor voter” applications to county voter registration officials.

PennDOT provides address change information to the Department. The Department forwards the information to the appropriate county voter registration office. In 2005, the Department forwarded 654,175 changes of address to county officials.

Agency Registration

In 2005, the Department continued to work with state-operated public assistance agencies and disability agencies to provide voter registration opportunities to clients. The following agencies participated:

County Assistance Offices; Clerk of Orphans’ Court and Marriage License Bureaus; Armed Forces Recruitment Centers; Women, Infants, and Children Nutrition Clinics; District Offices of the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation; District Offices of the Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services; State Mental Health Hospitals and State Mental Retardation Centers; the Area Agencies on Aging; Contractors for the Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services; Centers for Independent Living; County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Offices; Student Disability Services Offices of the State System of Higher Education; the Offices of Special Education; and the American with Disabilities Act Complementary Para-transit Offices.

To assist these agencies, the Department continues to provide *A Guide to Agency-Based Voter Registration*. This publication details the responsibilities of a mandated voter registration agency. In addition to the guide, the Department provides each agency with Voter Registration Mail Applications, posters encouraging voter registration and a brochure, *Your Vote is Your Voice*, which describes the voter registration process.

The Department of State also conducts training sessions and provides technical assistance to agencies when needed. These agencies provide approximately 1,500 additional sites where individuals are offered the opportunity to apply to register to vote.

The Help America Vote Act (HAVA): Act 150 of 2002 and Act 97 of 2004

The Help America Vote Act (HAVA) of 2002 was signed into law by President George W. Bush on October 29, 2002. HAVA’s main objective is uniform and non-discriminatory election administration. The Act contains several provisions related to voter registration, poll worker training and accessibility requirements. Such requirements extend to language and physical accessibility.

Pennsylvania enacted Act 150 of 2002 to incorporate many HAVA requirements into the Pennsylvania Election Code. Act 97 of 2004 made additional amendments to procedures applicable to provisional ballots, as noted below.

Poll Worker/Election Official Training

The Department developed a training program that includes the current laws and procedures for processing voters on Election Day, voting systems operation and canvassing votes and counting ballots (including absentee and provisional ballots) after the close of the polls.

Throughout 2005, the Department developed and conducted poll-worker certification training in Union and Montour counties. The training focused on pre-election and Election Day procedures, including opening and closing the polls, canvassing votes and returning elections materials.

Polling Place Accessibility

In 2005, the Department disbursed funding to the counties to increase the number of accessible polling places in the Commonwealth. To further this effort, the Department held meetings with accessibility advocates, including the Polling Place Accessibility Advisory Group formed by county officials and independent groups.

The Department directed a survey that collected data from all 67 counties regarding the accessibility of currently utilized polling places. The Accessibility Advisory Group developed the accessibility standards. Of the 9,381 polling places in the Commonwealth, 7,167 have been found to be accessible. 2,198 are inaccessible, mostly due to the lack of handicapped parking signs and the presence of steps and doorknobs that are not easily opened by disabled voters.

The counties used most of the funding to replace doorknobs, eliminate obstructive steps, build ramps, install handrails and place handicapped parking signs.

Alternative Language Assistance

Pursuant to Section 301 of HAVA, in 2005, the Department continued to translate into Spanish all relevant voter materials, including registration forms. These materials were provided to all 67 counties. In addition, the Department's www.votespa.com website contains information in both English and Spanish.

The Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE): Act 3 of 2002

Before HAVA's enactment, Pennsylvania began developing the Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE) when the General Assembly enacted Act 3 of 2002. The Act set forth system requirements, specifying that SURE must be a "single, uniform, integrated computer system. All [voter registration] commissions shall be connected electronically to the SURE system and shall maintain their registration records in the system." Act 3 also made several amendments to the voter registration act to make voter registration processes more amenable to electronic processing.

SURE is a centralized, statewide voter registration and election management system designed to ensure the accuracy and integrity of the Commonwealth's voter registration records

maintained by election authorities in Pennsylvania's counties. The SURE system supports critical election functions, including determining voter eligibility, assigning precincts and producing poll books. By placing all counties on a common software platform:

- Duplicate registrations across county lines are presented to election officials for resolution.
- When registered voters move across county lines, existing records and voting history are transferred to the new county of residence.
- External agency transactions from PennDOT and the Department of Health (DOH) that affect voter eligibility are centrally integrated with SURE and electronically forwarded to county officials.
- A single interface to PennDOT and the Social Security Administration (SSA) provides access to information for driver's license and social security number verification in compliance with HAVA.
- HAVA voter identification requirements are implemented uniformly throughout the Commonwealth.
- Voter registry maintenance programs operate on a consistent statewide basis to keep the registry up-to-date, protect against potential voter fraud and promote consistent data management practices.

The Department began implementing SURE during the summer in 2002. Four pilot counties were live on SURE in time for the 2003 Primary Election. The Department added two larger counties prior to the November 2003 General Election. With the addition of 50 counties, 56 counties were live for the 2004 Primary Election.

The Department worked with the vendor during the spring of 2005 to develop a Go-Forward Strategy for Full Implementation (Strategy). The Strategy defined specific performance goals for the system to meet prior to the remaining eleven counties going live. In addition, it outlined functional enhancements, including data entry and absentee processing. The Department also presented its long-term project goals, including report-writer capability, a Dynamic Import Process for voter registration applications and several "portal" views for SURE data. These portals will allow county and state officials and public constituents to access SURE information without compromising system security or performance.

During the summer of 2005, SURE was tested strenuously for performance and capacity. First, a baseline performance test was conducted. Following a software upgrade installation aimed at improving performance, the system was retested. The performance test results, which were confirmed by a third party, proved that SURE had met the Strategy's performance goals and could handle the addition of the remaining counties without degrading performance for all counties.

As a result, the remaining eleven counties went live on SURE during the last few months in 2005. Ten counties were added in August and September 2005. On December 27, 2005, Philadelphia became the last county to be live. By having all counties live before the end of 2005, Pennsylvania successfully met HAVA's January 1, 2006 implementation deadline.

On January 20, 2006, the Department deployed a new software build and interface. This deployment satisfied HAVA requirements regarding driver's license and social security

number verification. Through SURE, county voter registration officials can access information in the PennDOT and SSA databases to verify the identity of all new voters.

Now that all counties use SURE and HAVA verification requirements are in place, the Department is focusing its efforts on the Strategy's long-term goals. Phase 1 of the portal development has been completed, including Internet functionality that allows voters to locate and get directions to their polling place. County and agency users can look up SURE data (without touching the live SURE system) and post news items and frequently asked questions to the website. Phase 2 of the portal development will include functionality that allows voters to apply to register or change their address online (with paper signature to follow) and view information on voting machines. The Department plans to further develop the portals, maximizing SURE's overall success.

The Address Confidentiality Program: Part of Act 188 of 2004

On November 30, 2004, Governor Edward G. Rendell signed into law Act 188 of 2004. Act 188 amended the Domestic Relations Code to add the Sexual Violence Victim Address Confidentiality Act and established the Address Confidentiality Program (Program) to be administered by the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole's Office of Victim Advocate, which was established by the Crime Victims Act. Under Act 188, the Program took effect on May 29, 2005.

The Address Confidentiality Program is not a victim/witness protection program; however, it may be used as an important part of a victim safety plan. The Program functions as a mail forwarding system for victims accepted into the Program. Program participants are provided with a legal substitute mailing address, which can be used in place of their actual address when utilizing state agency services. All first class, certified and registered mail is forwarded free of charge to the participants.

Individuals who participate in the Address Confidentiality Program and wish to register to vote do so in person at their county voter registration office. To limit the exposure of confidential information, participants speak directly to the county Voter Registration/Election Director or the Director's designee.

Participants complete a Voter Registration Mail Application (VRMA), which includes their residential address. These VRMAs, along with any other documents participants file with the county voter registration office, must be kept in a locked, confidential file. These documents are not subject to open records requests unless so required by a court, in which case they must be reviewed under a judge's supervision or in a judge's chambers. When participants register to vote, they also complete an application for an Alternative Ballot. Alternative Ballots are voted by mail thus eliminating the need for participants to physically appear at their polling place.

Voter Outreach Efforts

Voter Registration Application Mailing to High School Seniors

In March 2005, Governor Rendell and the Department continued its voter registration program aimed at graduating high school seniors. Through this initiative, the Department sent VRMAs to every public and private high school in the state. High school administrators were asked to deliver the applications to graduating high school seniors who would be 18 before Primary Election Day. The Department distributed over 151,000 voter registration application forms to high school seniors to increase the number of younger registered voters, a demographic that is historically underrepresented.

Revised Informational Voter Registration Pamphlets

In June 2005, the Department revised, printed and distributed the informational pamphlet, *Your Vote Is Your Voice* to the county boards of election and government agencies across the Commonwealth. The revisions included useful information on how to register to vote, how to obtain an absentee ballot and the purpose and proper use of provisional ballots. The pamphlet also describes acceptable forms of identification voters may use to satisfy the first time voter identification requirements under HAVA and Act 150 of 2002.

Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame

The Department administers the Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame program. The program was established to generate awareness and encourage Pennsylvanians to exercise their right to vote. This program publicly honors Pennsylvanians who have voted in at least 50 consecutive November elections. Voter Hall of Fame inductees serve as ambassadors for voter participation, encouraging others to emulate the inductees' commitment to our democratic process. The Department maintains a database of inductees on its website as well as a permanent display on the third floor of the North Office Building.

In 2005, the Department inducted 65 citizens from 10 counties into the Voter Hall of Fame. Two ceremonies were held in Mifflin and Carbon counties where 13 and 32 members were inducted, respectively. The 65 new members bring total membership to 12,664. Members of the Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame represent 60 different counties across the Commonwealth.

Vote With A Vet Program

In the fall of 2005, the Department, in cooperation with the Departments of Education and Military and Veterans Affairs, conducted its annual *Vote With a Vet* program. The program gathers detailed biographies of Pennsylvania veterans. These biographies are sent to Pennsylvania schools, along with VRMAs. Since the program's inception, the Department has mailed more than 14,000 biographies to age-eligible students. *Vote With a Vet* is an attempt to reverse the trend of voter apathy among younger voters by impressing upon them the sacrifices Pennsylvania veterans have made to safeguard our democracy.

In October 2005, representatives from the Departments of State and Military and Veterans Affairs made a presentation to students at Donegal High School in Lancaster County. The students were members of history and civics classes who had participated in the *Vote With a Vet* program. Presenters included the Secretary of the Commonwealth, veterans, students and other community members.

The Department encourages members of the General Assembly who are veterans to complete a "Veteran Biography Form." Anyone may complete a "Deceased/MIA Veteran Biography Form" on behalf of a veteran. Please contact the Department's Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation to request either form.

- Appendix III contains data for the various voter registration methods. Total applications include new registrations, changes of address and changes of name or party regardless of whether the application was valid, rejected or a duplicate. Valid applications include only new registration applications that were accepted by the county voter registration commissions. This appendix includes column charts. One depicts various methods of application from 2003-2005, and the other compares the number of total and valid applications.

- Appendix IV contains data relative to list maintenance activities in the counties for the period covered by this report. In addition to confirmation mailings and the National Change of Address Program, list maintenance activities include the number of changes of address received from PENNDOT and processed, the number of address verification notices mailed in accordance with Section 1901 (d)(2) of the PVRA, the number of five-year notices mailed and the number of responses to these notices, the number of registration files marked inactive at the end of 2004, and the number of active and inactive voter registrations which were cancelled. (The “motor voter” litigation settlement agreement permits the counties to send out five-year notices in accordance with Section 1901 (b)(3) of the PVRA.) In some instances the five year notices were mailed in the prior calendar year and the responses to the notice received in 2004.
- Appendix V contains data for “motor voter” applications by political party. This information is provided directly from DataCard/VIISAGE Corporation, the contracted vendor who processes the applications for the Department of State and PENNDOT. These statistics relate to the number of individuals who applied to register to vote at a photo license center. Because it is a centralized computer process, statistics can be provided by political party. The total number of applications provided by DataCard/VIISAGE may differ from the counties’ total applications received from PENNDOT for a variety of reasons, including not having been received by the counties until the next reporting period.
- Appendix VI contains the number of changes of address received by PENNDOT that were forwarded to the county voter registration commissions. These numbers differ from the numbers the counties report (Appendix IV) because they include all changes reported to PENNDOT regardless of whether or not the individual was registered.
- Appendix VII depicts a pie chart listing the distribution of the voter registration mail applications. This chart does not reflect distributions to the 67 county voter registration offices.




