Members of the General Assembly:

As Secretary of the Commonwealth, I am pleased to report to you on the administration of voter registration in Pennsylvania for the calendar year 2006.

In 2006, the Department of State's partnership with the 67 county elections and voter registration commissions and personnel involved in agency based voter registration programs resulted in the addition of 385,735 voters to the voter registration rolls.

The Department continued its work in administering agency-based voter registration programs as required under the National Voter Registration Act. Additionally, we offered training and supplies to those agencies.

The past year saw the continued implementation of Act 3 of 2002 (Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors – SURE). Many improvements were designed to enhance the ability of citizens, as well as county and state officials, to participate more fully in our elections process. SURE is one of the tools that promises to enhance the democratic process for the citizens of the Commonwealth in the 21st century.

The Department of State is also committed to fulfilling its responsibilities under the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA). This includes promoting voter registration, awareness and outreach activities across the Commonwealth.

We hope that you find this Annual Report informative and useful. If you have any questions regarding this report, my staff and I would be pleased to assist you.

The Administration of Voter Registration in Pennsylvania
2006 Report to the General Assembly

In 2006, the Department of State (Department) worked closely with the 67 county voter registration offices, Commonwealth agencies designated with voter registration responsibilities, the public, voter registration advocacy groups and the affected state and local agencies to administer voter registration in Pennsylvania. This report represents a summary of initiatives and statistics that support voter registration administration in Pennsylvania.

Department of Transportation

Since 1995, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has played an integral role in the voter registration process. PennDOT provides Commonwealth citizens with an opportunity to apply to register to vote while receiving or renewing their driver's license at a PennDOT photo license center. In 2006, more than 226,000 individuals applied to register to vote using this resource.

Application Process to Register to Vote at a Photo License Center

- PennDOT customers visit a photo license center with a driver's license application card, provided by PennDOT, which contains a printed two-dimensional bar code. The bar code is scanned, and the computer system determines the customer's age. It then determines which customers will be at least eighteen years old by the date of the next election and asks if the customer wishes to apply to register to vote.
- The program is designed to ask customers if they are already registered to vote. If not, they are provided the opportunity to apply to register.
- Customers can view the qualifications a Pennsylvania citizen must meet to continue with the application.
- Customers who choose to apply for voter registration are asked to confirm their county of residence, indicate a party preference and type their telephone number and race, which are both optional.
- Customers are advised of the penalty for furnishing false information and are asked to sign a declaration that the information they have provided is true and correct to the best of their knowledge.
- Customers are provided with a receipt indicating pertinent information about their voter registration application, including the date on which they applied at the photo license center. The receipt instructs customers to contact their county voter registration office if they do not receive a voter identification card within two weeks.

The PennDOT computer system stores the completed voter registration applications and transmits the data to Viisage, the contracted vendor. The vendor electronically sorts the applications by county and transmits them electronically to each county voter registration office. In 2006, the vendor forwarded 226,362 “motor voter” applications to county voter registration officials.

PennDOT provides address change information to the Department. The Department forwards the information to the appropriate county voter registration office. In 2006, the Department forwarded 836,347 changes of address to county officials.

Agency Registration

In 2006, the Department continued to work with state-operated public assistance agencies and disability agencies to provide registration opportunities to clients. The following agencies participated:

County Assistance Offices; Clerk of Orphans’ Court and Marriage License Bureaus; Armed Forces Recruitment Centers; Women, Infants, and Children Nutrition Clinics; District Offices of the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation; District Offices of the Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services; State Mental Health Hospitals and State Mental Retardation Centers; the Area Agencies on Aging; Contractors for the Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services; Centers for Independent Living; County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Offices; Student Disability Services Offices of the State System of Higher Education; the Offices of Special Education; and the American with Disabilities Act Complementary Para-transit Offices.

To assist these agencies, the Department continues to provide *A Guide to Agency-Based Voter Registration*. This publication details the responsibilities of a mandated voter registration agency. In addition to the guide, the Department provides each agency with Voter Registration Mail Applications, posters encouraging voter registration and brochures, *Your Vote is Your Voice*, which describes the voter registration process.

The Department of State also conducts training sessions and provides technical assistance to agencies when needed. These agencies provide approximately 1,500 additional sites where individuals are offered the opportunity to apply to register to vote.

The Help America Vote Act (HAVA): Act 150 of 2002 and Act 97 of 2004

President George W. Bush signed the Help American Vote Act (HAVA) of 2002 into law on October 29, 2002. HAVA’s main objective is uniform and non-discriminatory election administration. The Act contains several provisions related to voter registration, poll worker training and accessibility requirements. Such requirements extend to language and physical accessibility.

Pennsylvania enacted Act 150 of 2002 to incorporate many HAVA requirements into the Pennsylvania Election Code. Act 97 of 2004 made additional amendments to procedures applicable to provisional ballots, as noted below.

Poll Worker/Election Official Training

The Department developed a training program that includes the current laws and procedures for processing voters on Election Day, voting systems operation and canvassing voted and counting ballots (including absentee and provisional ballots) after the close of the polls.

In 2006, the Department began research for a new training program. The Department conducted surveys and began working on the new training materials and expects to have a video training completed by the end of 2007.

Polling Place Accessibility

After receiving completed surveys from the counties, the Department created and maintained a survey results database to allocate and distribute all the Title II, Section 261 funds. The surveys also assist the Department with monitoring the status of inaccessible polling places. The results from the most recent survey show a total of 9,355 polling places in the Commonwealth (7,545 accessible and 1,810 inaccessible). Although the number of polling places decreased from the previous survey, the number of accessible polling places increased due to improvements and consolidations.

The Department applied for federal assistance (SF-424) and received \$405,621.00 for fiscal year 2006. The funds were disbursed in the same percentages as previous distributions (60% for polling place accessibility, 20% for compliant voting systems, 10% for training election staff, and 10% for voter information programs).

For fiscal year 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006, the Commonwealth has allocated a total of \$1,652,036.95 in Title II, Section 261 grants as follows:

- \$991,222.17 for making polling places, including the path of travel, entrances, exits, and voting areas of each polling facility, accessible to individuals with the full range of disabilities.
- \$330,407.40 for providing the same opportunity for access and participation (including privacy and independence) to individuals with the full range of disabilities as for other voters.
- \$165,203.70 for training election officials, poll workers, and election volunteers on how best to promote the access and participation of individuals with the full range of disabilities in elections for federal offices.

- \$165,203.70 for providing individuals with the full range of disabilities with information about polling place accessibility.

Alternative Language Assistance

Pursuant to Section 301 of HAVA, in 2005, the Department continues to translate all relevant voter materials into Spanish. The following documents were also translated into Chinese, French, Korean, Russian and Vietnamese:

- Elections News
- Qualifications to register to vote
- Voter registration form
- Absentee ballot application
- Instructions for alternative ballot
- Absentee ballot application
- Emergency absentee ballot application
- Provisional voting information

These forms are available on our www.votespa.com website. The department engaged a partnership with the Department of Homeland Security/ US Citizenship and Immigration Services, Pennsylvania Immigration and Citizenship Coalition, and Project SHINE from Temple University for the production of a voting guide for new citizens.

The Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE); Act 3 of 2002

The Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE) is a centralized voter registration and election management system designed to assure the accuracy and integrity of the Commonwealth's voter registration records maintained by the election authorities of Pennsylvania's 67 counties. The SURE system is a platform that supports the critical functions of the Commonwealth's elections—from determining voter eligibility to assigning precincts to producing poll books. A centralized, uniform registry that is accessible to all county offices greatly enhances overall accuracy and integrity of the voter registration rolls, and the resulting quality of voter services.

Pennsylvania began development of its centralized voter registration system with the enactment of Act 3 of 2002. Act 3 of 2002 sets forth the requirements for the system, specifying that SURE must be a “single, uniform integrated computer system. All [voter registration] commissions shall be connected electronically to the SURE system and shall maintain their registration records in the system.” Act 3 also makes a number of amendments to the voter registration act that make voter registration processes more amenable to electronic processing.

The Help America Vote Act (HAVA) contains numerous requirements for improving the conduct of elections across the United States. One of these requirements is the

establishment of a statewide voter registration system in each state, which must be “single, uniform, official, centralized, interactive computerized statewide voter registration list defined, maintained, and administered at the State level that contains the name and registration information of every legally registered voter in the State and assigns a unique identifier to each legally registered voter in the State...” (See § 303(a)(1)(A), 42 U.S.C. § 15483(a)(1)(A)). The SURE system was live in all Pennsylvania counties prior to the January 1, 2006 HAVA deadline.

All counties have used the SURE system for election and voter registration-related functions since the last county was brought onto SURE in late 2005. The year 2006, four years into the project, brought about a period of review and consideration of options to enhance and move forward with the SURE system. As a part of this assessment process, the Department contracted with Infotech Consulting in September to conduct a Gap Analysis of the SURE project. The purpose of the Gap Analysis was to provide a review of a number of options for the continued enhancement and support of the SURE application. The Gap Analysis report, completed in January 2007, provided an outline of gaps that existed between the various options and was used as a basis to make decisions on the future of the SURE system.

Subsequently, the Department, in consultation with the Office of Administration, decided to pursue a contract with a vendor to rewrite the SURE system program with the intent of working to improve and tailor the system for the future needs of the Commonwealth. This reprogramming project will continue until its planned completion in 2009.

In the meantime, the SURE system continues to be improved upon. During 2006, the Department implemented three software releases in SURE (January, March, and September). The January 2006 Release completed the implementation of the HAVA-required check of driver’s license and social security numbers of new registrants against the PennDOT and Social Security Administration databases, respectively. The implementation of this process brought the SURE system into full compliance with HAVA. The 2006 software releases also brought about improvements in the following areas, among others: implementation of the canvass voter removal program; addition of new reports and correspondence items; modifications to duplicate voter search process to facilitate searching capabilities and improve accuracy of processing voter changes; improvement to processing of voters covered by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizen Absentee Voters Act (UOCAVA); and modifications to existing reports and correspondence items. Each software release was accompanied by updated documentation and release notes detailing the changes that were made to SURE.

The SURE office began to offer refresher training for new and veteran users of SURE during June and July of 2006. During this period, SURE team members conducted four 2-day introductory training sessions for 38 users. These sessions included an overview of basic information about the SURE system, as well as a review of voter information and applications, the absentee ballot process, maintenance of polling places and poll workers, the process for recording voter history, and how to produce reports. Also during the summer of 2006, SURE team members conducted two 1-day advanced training sessions

for 22 experienced users. The topics for this session included redistricting, data clean-up, system utilities and wizards, issuing second absentee ballots to voters, as well as common system errors and workarounds.

During 2006 the SURE Office fulfilled approximately 200 requests from the public for voter data in an electronic format, including Full Voter Exports, Street Lists, Public Information Lists, and Walking Lists. In July 2006, the SURE team developed an easier method of extracting SURE data for this purpose, resulting in a much lower cost to the public.

SURE Portal

As the SURE project at the Department of State developed and expanded over the past several years, it became apparent that there are many areas of voter registration and election management that could be addressed and improved outside of the official SURE system. The Department embarked on the SURE Portal project in 2005 in order to address some of these areas, while taking advantage of the great progress that has been made in the Commonwealth with the SURE system. Having all counties on the same software platform for voter registration management, as well as the development of a single centralized database of voter data, has made possible many of the SURE Portal's functions.

The overall goals of the SURE Portal are:

- To make use of SURE information to support an expanded array of services and functionality for county, agency, and public users.
- To move some critical county processes outside of the SURE environment, optimizing performance for the official registration system.
- To make SURE information more readily available for county, agency, and public use and reference.
- To provide streamlined, electronic processes to the public and to county offices to support the voter registration and elections process.
- To make voter registration information and processes available to the public via the Internet to the greatest extent possible under Pennsylvania law.

Three separate functional areas make up the SURE Portal: the Public Portal, the County Portal, and the Agency Portal.

The SURE Public Portal provides access to many aspects of the voter registration and elections process directly to the public via the Internet at www.pavoterservices.state.pa.us. On the Public Portal website, voters may:

- Search for and view their own registration and polling place information, including directions to their polling place
- Apply to change their voter registration information or complete a new application online, with paper signature to follow (imported into SURE via the Dynamic Import Process)

- Apply for an absentee ballot (ability to transfer to SURE electronically planned for the future)
- Access valuable information regarding the elections process in their own counties, including information on voting systems and county-specific office information, polling place information, news, FAQs, events, and links
- Search for provisional ballot status
- Participate in a threaded discussion
- Search for a Voter Hall of Fame inductee

The SURE County Portal was developed with the intent of expanding the range of voter registration and election management functions that can be performed by county users outside of the SURE system proper. Users of the County Portal do not necessarily have to be users of the SURE system. This makes it possible to allow temporary workers, for example, to perform many election-related duties without accessing the SURE system. The County Portal provides the following functions to county users:

- Voter search capability
- Scanning and data entry of voter registration applications (entered into the Portal and imported into SURE via the Dynamic Import Process)
- Posting of county-specific office information, polling place information, news, FAQs, events, and links to the Public Portal website
- Entry, processing, and certification of provisional ballots
- Voter registration statistics certification
- Report generation and printing
- Verification of voting system software

Future functionality planned for the County Portal includes electronic poll books and the ability to upload election returns to the Department.

In addition, the Public Kiosk has been deployed as a part of the County Portal. This feature was developed so that county election offices may, if they choose, provide a public computer terminal to customers so that they can access many features of the Portal in the county office. Public users of the Kiosk have the ability to perform the following functions:

- Search for and view voter registration information for any voter in the county (after completing an affirmation and showing identification to an election official)
- Change their voter registration information or complete a new application electronically (application is submitted directly to SURE)
- Access valuable information regarding the elections process in their own counties, including information on voting systems and county-specific news, FAQs, and links
- Search for provisional ballot status

The SURE Agency Portal provides useful elections functionality to the Department of State. The functionality provided to Department of State users includes the ability to:

- Research registered voters through the lookup capability as requests are received
- Accept voter registration statistics from county voter registration offices electronically via the Portal
- Post statewide news, links, FAQs, and voting system information to the Public Portal website

The Agency Portal also provides the ability for the Department of State to deploy Public Kiosks for customer use.

During 2006 the SURE Portal Team developed and improved many features of the application for use by the public as well as for county and agency users. Each software release that was deployed was accompanied by the publication of a user guide. The following software releases were deployed during 2006:

- July: Deployed version 2.5, which established the ability to scan voter registration applications and receive information electronically from applicants who completed their voter applications on the Internet.
- October: Deployed version 3.0, which added a voter data export and the ability to enter provisional ballot information via the Portal. It also established the ability for counties to enter and certify to the Department official voter registration statistics and check on the security of their voting systems.
- December: Deployed version 3.5, which implemented the prototype for a report writer and converted the system to a .NET 2.0 platform.

In addition to the online public component, the following users have been granted access and are utilizing their respective areas of the Portal:

- Agency Users: DOS Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation and the Pennsylvania State Police.
- County Users:
 - Portal deployed and users trained: Berks, Centre, Clarion, Franklin, Lebanon, Luzerne, Monroe, and Snyder.
 - Portal deployed, but users not yet trained: Allegheny, Bradford, Clearfield, Clinton, Forest, Greene, Jefferson, Lancaster, Pike, Somerset, Warren, and Wayne.
 - Scheduled for Portal deployment: Beaver, Bucks, Carbon, Cumberland, Dauphin, Elk, Indiana, Lackawanna, Lycoming, Mercer, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Tioga, Washington, Westmoreland, Wyoming, and York.

Overall, the SURE and the SURE Portal are works in progress. Many improvements are planned to enhance the ability of citizens, as well as county and state officials, to

participate more fully in the elections process. SURE is one of the tools that promises to enhance the democratic process for the citizens of the Commonwealth in the 21st century.

Voter Outreach Efforts

Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame

The Department administers the Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame program. The program was established to generate awareness and encourage Pennsylvanians to exercise their right to vote. This program publicly honors Pennsylvanians who have voted in at least 50 consecutive November elections. Voter Hall of Fame inductees serve as ambassadors for voter participation, encouraging other to emulate the inductees on its website as well as a permanent display on the third floor of the North Office Building.

In 2006, the Department inducted 127 citizens from 12 counties into the Voter Hall of Fame. There were two ceremonies held in Lycoming and Carbon counties where 78 and 27 members were inducted, respectively. The 127 new members bring total membership to 12,791. Members of the Pennsylvania Voter Hall of Fame represent 61 different counties across the Commonwealth.

Vote With A Vet Program

In the fall of 2006, the Department, in cooperation with the Department of Education and Military and Veterans Affairs, conducted its annual *Vote With a Vet* program. The program gathers detailed biographies of Pennsylvania veterans. These biographies are sent to Pennsylvania schools, along with Voter Registration Mail Applications. Since the program's inception, the Department has mailed more than 14,000 biographies to age-eligible students. *Vote With a Vet* is an attempt to reverse the trend of voter apathy among younger voters by impressing upon them the sacrifices Pennsylvania veterans have made to safeguard our democracy.

In October 2006, the Department sent out Voter Registration Mail Applications and Veteran biographies to 26 High Schools across the Commonwealth. More than 1,200 students participated in the program and it concluded in a great success. Students also had the opportunity to participate in honoring a deceased veteran.

The Department encourages members of the General Assembly who are veterans to complete a "Veteran Biography Form." Anyone may complete a "Deceased/MIA Veteran Biography Form" on behalf of a veteran. Please contact the Department's Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation to request either form.

Student Mock Election

The Commonwealth conducts the *Pennsylvania Student Mock Election Program*, initiated in 1988, every two years during the General Election as an attempt to educate school-age youth about the voting process. Students participate in a mock election in their respective schools throughout the Commonwealth and vote for offices such as President and Vice President or Governor and Lieutenant Governor. The ballot also contains several ballot questions, including school and education-related issues, to promote and encourage participation in the program.

In 2006, with the assistance of the Department of Education, the Department of State conducted the 2006 *Pennsylvania Student Mock Election Program*. Over 250 Schools involving more than 84,000 students participated in this program. Each participating school received a Teachers' Manual to assist educators in administering the Mock Election. All schools reported their election results for Governor, Lt. Governor and U.S Senate online.

- Appendix III contains data for the various voter registration methods. Total applications include new registrations, changes of address and changes of name or party regardless of whether the application was valid, rejected or a duplicate. Valid applications include only new registration applications that were accepted by the county voter registration commissions. This appendix includes column charts. One depicts various methods of application from 2004-2006, and the other compares the number of total and valid applications.

- Appendix IV contains data relative to list maintenance activities in the counties for the period covered by this report. In addition to confirmation mailings and the National Change of Address Program, list maintenance activities include the number of changes of address received from PENNDOT and processed, the number of address verification notices mailed in accordance with Section 1901 (d)(2) of the PVRA, the number of five-year notices mailed and the number of responses to these notices, the number of registration files marked inactive at the end of 2004, and the number of active and inactive voter registrations which were cancelled. (The “motor voter” litigation settlement agreement permits the counties to send out five-year notices in accordance with Section 1901 (b)(3) of the PVRA.) In some instances the five-year notices were mailed in the prior calendar year and the responses to the notice received in 2006.
- Appendix V contains data for “motor voter” applications by political party. This information is provided directly from DataCard/VIISAGE Corporation, the contracted vendor who processes the applications for the Department of State and PENNDOT. These statistics relate to the number of individuals who applied to register to vote at a photo license center. Because it is a centralized computer process, political parties can provide statistics. The total number of applications provided by DataCard/VIISAGE may differ from the counties’ total applications received from PENNDOT for a variety of reasons, including not having been received by the counties until the next reporting period.
- Appendix VI contains the number of changes of address received by PENNDOT that were forwarded to the county voter registration commissions. These numbers differ from the numbers the counties report (Appendix IV) because they include all changes reported to PENNDOT regardless of whether or not the individual was registered.
- Appendix VII depicts a pie chart listing the distribution of the voter registration mail applications. This chart does not reflect distributions to the 67 county voter registration offices.

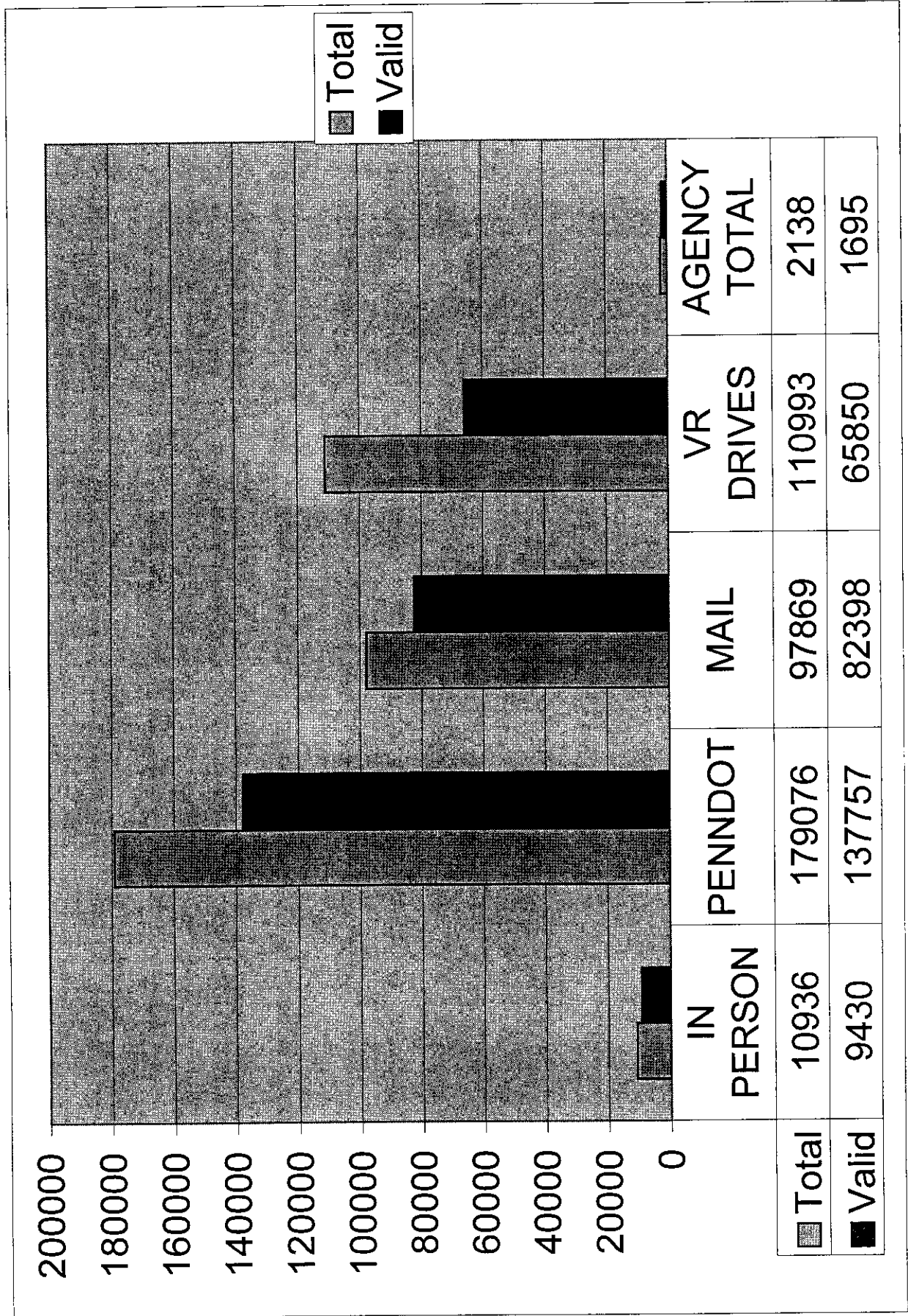

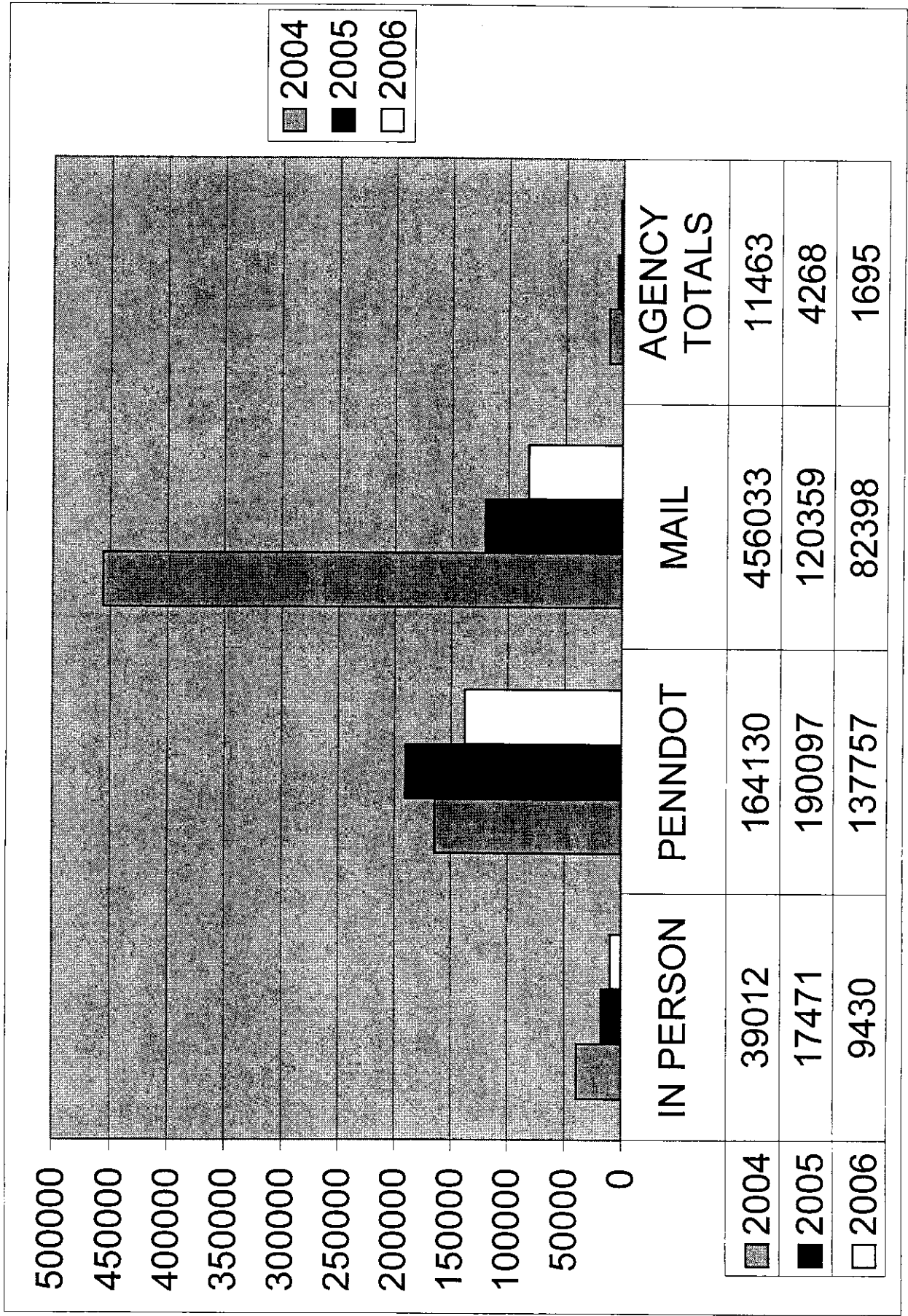
