FID Application Window Announcement

The application to offer a Flexible Instructional Day (FID) program during the 2024-2025 school year will be available on the PDE website by April 1, 2024. Public school entities will access and submit the FID application via the Future Ready Comprehensive Planning Portal (FRCPP). The deadline for submitting applications for the 2024-2025 school year is June 1, 2024.

Public school entities that had an accepted FID application beginning with the 2021-22 school year should decide whether to reapply as their application will expire at the end of the 2023-24 school year. School entities cannot use an FID without an accepted application. A list of accepted applicants with effective and termination dates can be found on the Flexible Instructional Day Program webpage.

The Keystone State ChalleNGe Academy is Now Accepting Applications for 2024 Class

The <u>Keystone State ChalleNGe Academy (KSCA)</u> is accepting applications for its fifth class of cadets, which begins in July 2024. The KSCA is designed to give academically challenged teens a second chance at obtaining their basic education, learn leadership, self-discipline, and responsibility to build a better life.

The program is open to 16-18-year-old male and female Pennsylvania residents who are failing to progress in high school or may not be on a clear path to graduating. Applicants must be willing to be drug free, free of felony convictions, and voluntarily commit to the program. The program lasts for 17 months, with the first five months consisting of residential training at ETIG followed by one year of mentorship back in the community

Information Regarding the Educator Pipeline Support Grant Program

he **Educator Pipeline Support Grant Program** will be administered by **PHEAA (PA Higher Education Assistance Agency)** and includes \$10,000 grants to student teachers, or \$15,000 if the student teacher teaches in a school with high turnover; Cooperating teachers receive a grant of \$2,500.

Learn More About Becoming a Purple Star School

Purple Star Schools is a program that supports military-connected children as they relocate to new schools due to a parent's change in duty station. This designation is given to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and Private/Non-public schools for their commitment to serving active-duty military families and students. If your LEA or school is interested in applying for this designation and serving military families and military connected students, email RA-EDMILITARYFAMK12@pa.gov to request an application.
