

CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES PROCEDURE CHECKLIST
Infant Toddler and Preschool

The Early Intervention program has procedures that contain the following:

- All instances of abuse, neglect and exploitation within the past year are reported in accordance with PA Child Protective Services Law and Department policy, specifically,
 - Requirements for mandated reports to report directly to Child Line.

- Policies are in place that ensure:
 - All required clearances are obtained and maintained within timelines
 - A reporting process is in place for any suspected child abuse
 - Training requirements are implemented and maintained according to PA law and policy.

- Infant Toddler Only:** Policies are in place related to Reportable Incidents per EI Announcement 21-1.

- Preschool Only:** Policies are in place related to the Educator Discipline Act

- Ensuring staff are trained on new or updated procedures. *

- Effective date of the procedure.

*This item does not necessarily need to be found in every procedure; however, there must be at least one statement that indicates how training is provided on new or updated procedures.
