EVALUATION FOR ELIGIBILITY PROCEDURE CHECKLIST Preschool

The Early Intervention program has evaluation and assessment procedures that include the following:

- □ Use of nondiscriminatory language.
- □ Conducting the evaluation in the child's native language unless clearly not feasible.
- □ Use of qualified personnel for evaluations.
- Obtaining parental consent for initial and re-evaluations.
- □ Use of diagnostic instruments and standard tests for the purpose and population for which they are valid and reliable.
- □ Gathering both family and child assessment information.
- □ Review of current medical records, educational and other records.
- □ Ensuring timely evaluation and eligibility determination.
- Defining eligibility criteria per Announcement: El 13-08.
- □ Ensuring appropriate eligibility determinations for the Early Intervention program.
- □ Ensuring prior written notice is provided to the parent when the child is not eligible for Early Intervention services.
- □ Ensuring staff are trained on new or updated procedures. *
- □ Effective date of the procedure.

*This item does not necessarily need to be found in every procedure; however, there must be at least one statement that indicates how training is provided on new or updated procedures.
