## TRANSITON INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT PROCEDURE CHECKLIST Infant Toddler and Preschool

The early intervention program has procedures for a transition agreement that includes the following:

- Infant toddler and preschool Early Intervention program has a Local Transition Interagency Agreement.
- □ Transition Interagency Agreement has been updated within the past 12 months.
- □ The updated agreement includes:
  - Participant attendance for the transition meetings,
  - Location of the meeting and follow up correspondence,
  - Transfer of information and timelines for the transfer of information, including the early childhood outcome data,
  - Transition point-person from each agency,
  - Evaluation procedure agreements,
  - Procedures for children who are referred to early intervention within 90 days of their third birthday,
  - Timely notification from the infant toddler El program,
  - Person/s responsible for completing evaluations to ensure unnecessary reevaluation of children,
  - Timely development of an IFSP or IEP for the toddler, and
  - Assurance of compliance with requirements of Part C and Part B of IDEA.
- □ Ensuring staff are trained on new or updated procedures. \*
- □ Effective date of the procedure.

\*This item does not necessarily need to be found in every procedure; however, there must be at least one statement that indicates how training is provided on new or updated procedures.
