<b>Indicator:</b> Transition	
<b>Indicator Type:</b> Program Management	
<b>Item TR-1:</b> Does the infant toddler or preschool Early Intervention program collaborate in an effective and efficient manner to determine the eligibility of children who are transitioning from infant toddler to preschool Early Intervention services?	
<b>Infant Toddler and Preschool EI Criteria</b>	
<p>There is evidence, as it relates to the transition from one Early Intervention program to another, that the infant toddler or preschool Early Intervention program is effective through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strategies to coordinate evaluation services to eliminate duplication of evaluation resources while determining eligibility for the Early Intervention preschool program. Strategies could include, but are not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Use of information on child skills (i.e., assessment results) from the infant toddler program,</li> <li>○ Coordinated evaluation procedures for children close to transition age, and</li> <li>○ Coordinated use of evaluation teams for the timely determination of eligibility.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Strategies to use PELICAN and local data to review, evaluate and revise strategies as needed.</li> <li>• Strategies to efficiently determine the eligibility of toddlers who are referred to Early Intervention close to their third birthday; and</li> <li>• Strategies to ensure that eligibility determinations occur in a timely and fiscally responsible manner.</li> <li>• Process for inviting the infant toddler service coordinator to the IEP meeting, as requested by the parent,</li> <li>• Strategies to ensure required participants at the transition meeting and that the transition meeting is held at a mutually convenient place and time, and</li> <li>• Strategies for discussing the similarities and differences between the infant/toddler and preschool program with the family.</li> </ul>

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. During the Verification, interview the program supervisor or program coordinator according to the <b><i>Supervisor's Interview Protocol</i></b>.</li> <li>2. During the Verification, review other documents, if identified by the program supervisor or coordinator, which provide evidence of the ongoing review of procedures related to determining eligibility for children transitioning from infant toddler to preschool services.</li> </ol>

<b>Infant Toddler and Preschool EI Criteria</b>	
<p>There is evidence the Local Interagency Agreement related to transition has been updated within the past 12 months and includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participant attendance for the transition meetings,</li> <li>• Location of the meeting and follow up correspondence,</li> <li>• Transfer of information and timelines for the transfer of information,</li> <li>• Procedures for children who are referred to infant toddler Early Intervention close to their third birthday,</li> <li>• Procedures for children who are referred to the preschool Early Intervention program close to their transition to kindergarten,</li> <li>• Transition point-person from each agency,</li> <li>• Eligibility and evaluation procedure agreements,</li> <li>• Resolution of concerns,</li> <li>• Timely development of an IFSP or IEP for the toddler, and</li> <li>• The assurance of compliance with requirements of Part C and Part B of IDEA.</li> </ul>

<p>There is evidence of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Letter of invitation was sent to the family, the preschool Early Intervention program or other community services in time to be received 30 days prior to the transition conference unless the parties all agree to meet in shorter timelines.</li> </ul>	<p>There is evidence of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>By February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, the families of all children who are approaching the age for kindergarten or first grade have been notified of the transition to school age process,</li> <li>Families have been provided the notice of Intent to Register for Kindergarten, and</li> <li>Program options have been explained to families including those not registering for kindergarten and staying in Early Intervention.</li> </ul>

<b>Directions for Finding Evidence</b>

<p>Prior to the Verification review the records in PELICAN of 5% of children who transitioned from the infant toddler to the preschool Early Intervention program using a <b>targeted record review</b>. At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. <b>Look for documentation of notification letter timelines in the transition plan and then in service coordination notes if further documentation is needed.</b></p>	<p>1. During the Verification, review the records of 5% of children who transitioned to a school age program using a <b>targeted record review</b>. At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation of notification letter timelines in the local child record.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>2. If the local program maintains a database for transition timelines (and not in the individual child records), use the local database. Look for documentation of the notification timelines for transition being met.</p>

<b>Directions for Finding Evidence</b>	
During the Verification, review the records of 5% of children who transitioned to a school age program using a <b>targeted record review</b> . Review the local program database for transition timelines. At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation of the date of the school age transition meeting.	
<b>Standards for Performance Rating</b>

<b>Directions for Finding Evidence</b>	
<b>Infant Toddler</b>	<b>Preschool</b>
Prior to the Verification, review the records in PELICAN of 5% of children who are transitioning from the infant toddler Early Intervention program using a <b>targeted record review</b> . At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation of the participants in the infant toddler transition meeting in the service coordination notes or local documentation. Look for documentation of reasonable notice provided to the preschool Early Intervention program.	During the Verification, review the documentation of 5% of children who transitioned from the infant toddler Early Intervention program using a <b>targeted record review</b> . At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation that preschool Early Intervention staff participated in the infant toddler transition conference.

<b>Item TR-7:</b> Does the preschool Early Intervention program develop the transition plan, as part of the IFSP/IEP according to timelines?	
<b>Preschool EI Criteria</b>	
There is evidence of the following: Within 1 year of transition to a program for school age students, the IEP contains outcomes/goals which address the transition process.

<b>Directions for Finding Evidence</b>	
Prior to the Verification, review the records in PELICAN of 5% of children who are transitioning to the school age program using a <b>targeted record review</b> . At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation that preschool Early Intervention program developed a transition plan in the IEP according to timelines.	
Within 1 year means –outcomes/goals must be included on the IEP at the most recent IEP meeting that is held prior to when the transition process begins. Some programs may start the process as early as November so transition outcomes/goals could be developed then, but they should not be developed later than February. Outcomes/goals should be documented on the transition plan of the IEP.

<b>Item TR-8:</b> Does the infant toddler or preschool Early Intervention program ensure the transition plan, as part of the IFSP/IEP, includes individualized steps to support the transition of the child to their next learning environment (e.g., home, community or educational environment)?	
<b>Infant Toddler and Preschool EI Criteria</b>	
<p>There is evidence that the transition plan includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An overall outcome/goal based on the individual child and family’s needs <b>related to transition</b> from Early Intervention and to preschool, community or next educational environment,</li> <li>• Documentation regarding future support and other matters related to transition,</li> <li>• Information from the special consideration section of the IFSP/IEP are addressed in the transition plan</li> <li>• Steps to prepare the toddler/young child for changes based on developmental needs, including activities to help the adjustment to and participation in new settings, and</li> <li>• Steps to ensure a smooth transition, including sharing of information, and convening a meeting with the family, preschool Early Intervention program and/or community provider, or school district.</li> </ul> <p>Transition plan information should be specific to the child and family, and should document the sharing of information, as well as all activities and specific steps that occur related to transition. It should include information related to all aspects of transition, including, but not limited to the transmission of information or skills needed by the child.</p> <p>For preschool programs, transition plan information it may also include specific dates for transition conferences, booklets from specific school districts.</p>

At least 5 records should be reviewed at minimum but no more than 15 records. Look for documentation of the transition plan criteria.
