



# 2022-23 Pennsylvania Migrant Education Program (PA-MEP)



**6,079**

total number of migrant children and youth were eligible and enrolled in the program between September 1, 2022 and August 30, 2023



**91%**

of children age 3 or older (who were not fluent in English) received English language support



**74%**

of migrant children and youth spoke Spanish as their primary language



**51%**

of migrant children and youth were identified as Priority for Service

**86% of enrolled children and youth received services**

**1,101** birth to PreK age children

**48%** of children ages 3-6 (and not yet in kindergarten) enrolled in preschool

**30%** of children ages 3 or older (and not yet in kindergarten) completed the Kindergarten Preparation Inventory (KPI)

**46%** of children ages 4 or older (and not yet in kindergarten) demonstrated kindergarten readiness

**79%** of children (with two data points) improved on the KPI

**4,079** K-12 students

**73%** of K-12 students with 2022 and 2023 English language proficiency assessment data (ACCESS for ELLs) improved

**73%** of students entering grade 11 had already passed Algebra 1 or a higher level math course

**92%** of students in grades 7-12 graduated or were promoted to the next grade

**60%** of graduates planned to attend a two-year or four-year college

**33%** of students in grades 8-12 participated in the Diploma Project

**899** Out-of-school youth

**80%** of out-of-school youth received PA-MEP services

**13** youth earned or were pursuing a high school equivalency diploma

**82%** of youth (who participated in a goal workshop and set goals) accomplished 50% or more of their goal steps

**42%** of youth participated in at least one iSOY (Instructional Services for Out-of-School and Secondary Youth) lesson

**16%** of youth with language screener results scored in the top quartile
