RE: 2021-2022 Report of Expenditures Relating to Exceptional Pennsylvania Students

As required by Act 16 of 2000 (Act 16), and amended by Act 55 of 2022, attached is the 2021-2022 Report of Expenditures Relating to Exceptional Pennsylvania Students. Act 16 requires the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to collect and report data from school districts and charter schools identifying the number of students with disabilities for which expenditures are between the following five categories:

| Category | Cost Range |
|-----------------|---------------------------|
| 1A | \$1.00 - \$4,999.99 |
| 1B | \$5,000 - \$27,303.07 |
| 2 | \$27,303.08 - \$54,606.16 |
| 3A | \$54,606.17 - \$81,909.25 |
| 3B | over \$81,909.25 |

The report is based on 2021-2022 school year data submitted by school districts and charter schools to PDE. In addition to the required Act 16 data, we have also included summary data information and comparisons from previous years' submissions.
