EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Section 1372 of the Public School Code requires the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to annually compile information listing the number of students with disabilities for which expenditures are under \$5,161.00 (Category 1A); between \$5,161.00 - \$28,182.23 (Category 1B); between \$28,182.24 - \$56,364.46 (Category 2); between \$56,364.47 - \$84,546.74 (Category 3A); and over \$84,546.74 (Category 3B) for the prior school year.¹

For the 2023-2024 submission, school districts and charter schools reported the cost of special education services per student with an Individualized Education Program (IEP) from July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024.

Data submitted by school districts and charter schools via Pennsylvania Information Management System (PIMS) was used to generate this report. School districts and charter schools reported the data at the student level using the PIMS Student Fact Template for Special Education Act 16 Funds. Data related to fiscal year (FY) 2023-24 costs were submitted during PIMS Collection #1 (October 1 through October 11, 2024).

The attached *Analysis of Exceptional Children* worksheet identifies and compares similar data reported in each of the last six years.

The data reported by the school districts and charter schools are each entity’s assessment of the individual cost of the delivery of special education services to each child in each category.

All 500 school districts and 174 charter schools submitted expenditure data for fiscal year 2023-24. The chart below shows the student count per cost category.

¹ Section 1372(8)(v) of the Public School Code requires PDE to beginning with the 2022-2023 school year “annually adjust the dollar ranges for which the information is collected...by the percentage change in the total special education expenditures submitted by school districts in the annual financial reports divided by the total weighted student headcount determined under section 2509.5 for the most recent year where data is available....”

To add a measure of fidelity and improve data accuracy, each school district or charter school that had an increase of 20 percent or greater from data reported for FY 2023-24 in any cost category was instructed to provide documentation to the PDE Bureau of Special Education to substantiate the reported data.

This data is reflective of data received on or by December 31, 2024. Any changes after December 31, 2024, will not be reflected in this report.
