A Brief Word on Words

Sexual violence:

a term meant to include any type of unwanted sexual contact

Domestic violence:

a pattern of coercive behavior used by one person to gain power and control over another in an intimate or familial relationship

“Victim” vs “Survivor”

Why we are here today?

1 in 5 women and 1 in 16 men are sexually assaulted while in college. 90% go unreported.

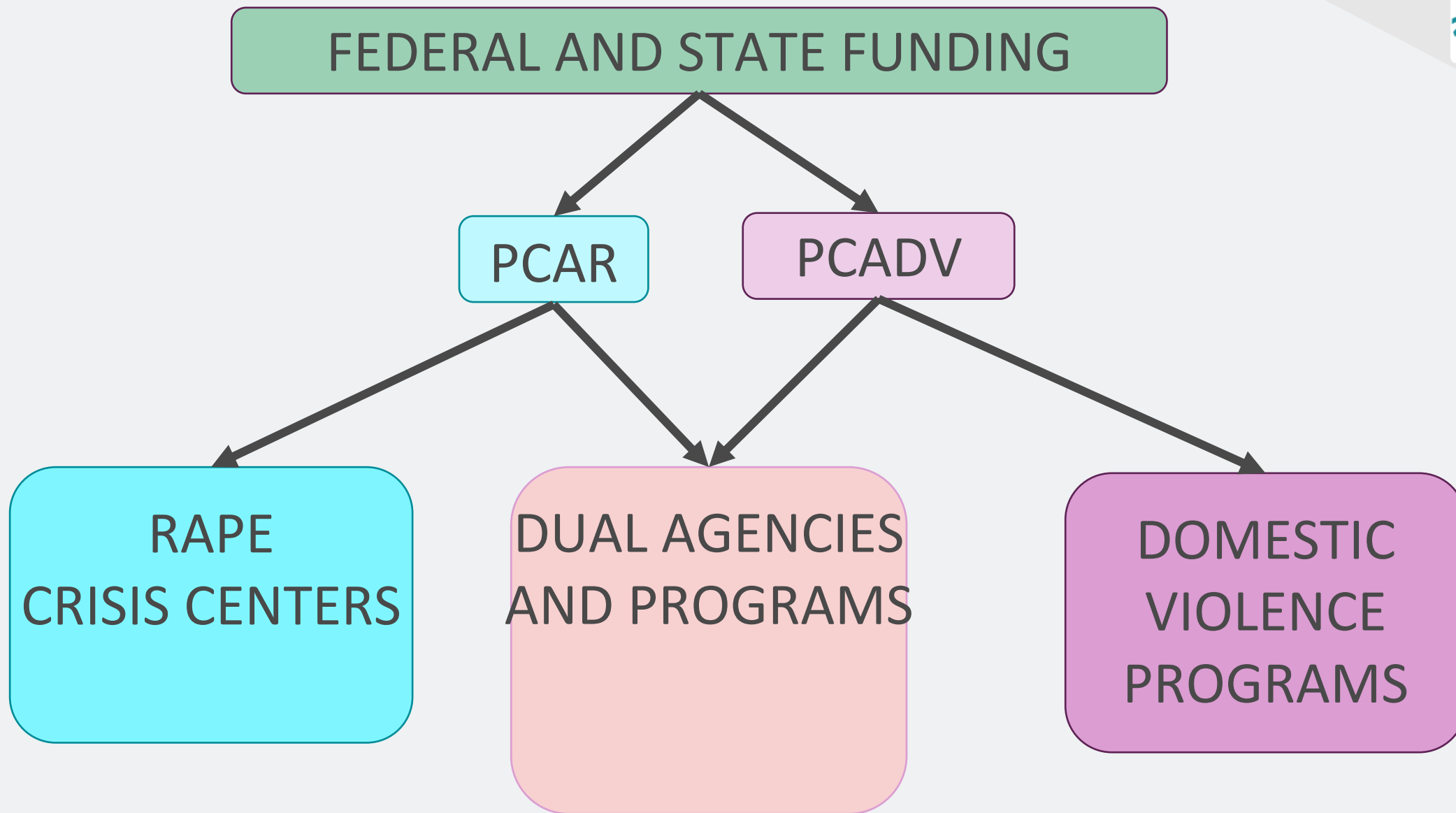
Nearly 63% of women and nearly 24% of men experience some form of sexual violence in their lifetime.

1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men experienced severe physical violence by an intimate partner.

Why PCAR and PCADV are necessary

43.8% of lesbian women and 61.1% of bisexual women have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner at some point in their lifetime, as opposed to 35% of heterosexual women.

LGBTQ students, black students, and students living with disabilities all have higher risks of being sexually assaulted on-campus.
