Form PFBC-ETS-001, Extended Trout Season Permit Application Instructions

NOTE: The extended trout season is in effect from the day after Labor Day until the third Monday of February of the following year. A creel limit of three trout per day and a minimum size limit of 7 inches applies during this season.

- 1. Section A: Applicant Information.
 - a. List the applicant's legal name. If the applicant is a corporation, trust, association, or other organized group, enter the entity's legal name.
 - b. List the applicant's address. For an entity as described above, list the principal place of business.
 - c. If applicable, list the jurisdiction under the laws of which the entity was created or organized, usually the state where entity is legally housed.
 - d. Enter form preparer name and title, if different from the applicant.
- 2. Section B: Waterbody Information.
 - a. List the details of each waterbody (for only the section you intend to utilize).
 - i. Provide waterbody name, county, and type. Enter section length or size.
 - ii. Indicate if the applicant is the owner or lessee of the land on which the waterbody is located. If not, indicate if the owner's permission has been obtained.
 - iii. Provide either GPS coordinates or location description for the section you intend to utilize.
 - 1. Enter GPS coordinates for the <u>most upstream</u> and <u>most downstream</u> points for flowing water (rivers/streams).
 - 2. Enter GPS coordinates for non-flowing water (lakes/ponds).
 - a. Use Google Maps or similar to find the Latitude and Longitude.
 - 3. Provide a location description using road names, bridges, and easily identifiable landmarks.
- 3. Options for application submittal:

 - b. Mail to: Bureau of Administration, PA Fish & Boat Commission, P.O. Box 67000, Harrisburg, PA 17106-7000.
- 4. Complete all sections fully. Incomplete applications will be returned without action.
- 5. Permit holders must re-apply for a new permit at expiration. PFBC does not issue renewals.
- 6. Any party, including the applicant, who is aggrieved by a decision of the Executive Director to grant or deny a permit under Section 2906 of the Code, may appeal the decision to the full Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission. Appeals must conform to 1 Pa. Code § 35.20. The Executive Director may stay a permit upon filing of an appeal. Appeals shall be disposed of in accordance with the General Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, as amended or supplemented by Commission rules.
