Rabbi Hazzan Dr. Jeffrey Myers - Tree of Life Synagogue, Pittsburgh PA Surviving the worst anti-semitic attack in U.S. history, Rabbi Myers addresses the responsibility of houses of worship to provide a balance between being open and welcoming, yet safe and secure.

Reverend Brenda Gregg - Destiny of Faith Church, Pittsburgh, PA In October 2022, the Destiny of Faith Church was the site of a mass shooting when two teenagers opened fire during a funeral and six individuals were injured.

Pastor Glenn Germany - Jesus' Dwelling Place Church, Pittsburgh, PA While conducting a sermon, Pastor Germany narrowly escaped harm when an attempted shooter's firearm jammed.
