In anticipation of the upcoming holidays, we will focus the last segment of our series on personal safety and security while shopping, both in person and online.

We will hear from Cortney Voorhees, Deputy Community Security Director, Jewish Federation of Greater Philadelphia. Ms. Voorhees will discuss the essential principles of enhancing personal safety and security in daily life. Attendees will learn how awareness, planning, and training play pivotal roles in reducing and mitigating personal risk.

Next will be a presentation from David Shallcross, Director of Senior Protection, Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, who will review ways to avoid holiday scams and fraud, and how to protect yourself while shopping online and in stores.

And lastly, we will hear from Christopher Allwein, Cyber Intelligence Manager, Bureau of Criminal Investigation, Pennsylvania State Police, Mr. Allwein will provide a brief overview of cyber security and resources that are available to the community.

Guidance and resources will be provided via handouts and there will be time set aside after each presentation for questions and answers.
