The Pennsylvania Insurance Department (“Department”) has completed its review of the application for Renaissance Reinsurance Ltd. (“the Company”) to renew its status as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer, filed pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3 and dated December 1, 2023.

The Company’s renewal application request is determined pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3. The Company is domiciled and licensed in Bermuda and appears to comply with the Pennsylvania requirements for jurisdiction to be on the NAIC List of Reciprocal Jurisdictions.

Based upon the Department’s review of the renewal application and in reliance upon the facts and representations contained herein, the Company continues to meet the requirements of 31 Pa. Code § 161.3 and is hereby approved as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer for life & health and property & casualty as the Company is authorized to engage in by its lead state regulator, Maryland Insurance Administration.

The Company’s status as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer remains effective for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 and is contingent upon the Company maintaining full compliance with all the provisions contained in 31 Pa. Code § 161.3.
