Winners from previous years may not be renominated in the same award category. Nominees who were **not** winners from previous years may be resubmitted for consideration. 4. Nominations must be written so the nominee's identity cannot be discerned by reading the narrative. *The name* and county of the nominee should only be written on the front page. 5. Nominations may be withdrawn by the Chief Juvenile Probation Officer or Judge who signed the nomination form. 6. Nominations must be submitted on this nomination form, using only the space provided. 7. Only one nomination per category per county will be accepted.
