BRIM pays settlement amounts up to \$250,000 and the Board is responsible for the remaining \$46,338.25.

Attorney Fox explained that Licensee was charged earlier this year with selling to 6 minors and letting 6 minors frequent the premises. In June 2018, Licensee waived both charges and the ALJ sustained both charges and imposed a fine of \$3,500.00.

Licensee later filed an application for reconsideration with the ALJ, but it was filed too late and rejected as untimely. Licensee subsequently appealed timely to the Board, asking us to make the ALJ reconsider and give licensee a suspension rather than a fine.

The Board does not have the authority to grant this appeal. Even if the licensee submitted its application in the mail within 15 days, it did not arrive at the OALJ until after the 15-day reconsideration period ended and OALJ goes by the date received.

While there is no regulation on point, the General Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure provide for a 15-day appeal period and the date of receipt is the one you go by, not when it is put in the mail. So, the ALJ did not err in rejecting the application.

Regardless, we cannot change a penalty because even if the Licensee had not signed a waiver, foregoing an appeal, the fine was well within the statutory range of section 471 and we cannot change it. The penalty range is \$1,000 - \$5,000 or suspension/revocation or both on each count.

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Member Negra: So Rod (Chief Counsel Diaz), we have two different regulations; Attorney Diaz: Yes, we use the postmark date; Member Negra: We could change the regulation to be consistent with Chief Counsel's procedure so that next year they will be the same; Attorney Diaz: Yes; Member Negra: Then Licensee does have an appeal to go?; Attorney Diaz: Yes. Attorney Fox closed by stating Chief Counsel's recommendation is to dismiss the appeal; deny *nunc pro tunc* relief and affirm the ALJ. The fine is still owed.

Attorney Fox described this appeal concerning a 2017 citation that was issued to Licensee charging Licensee with not being a *bona fide* restaurant, lacking the required number of chairs, and not having the required 400 square feet of serving area.

A hearing was held in May 2018 and the ALJ sustained both charges and imposed a \$300.00 fine which Licensee timely appealed. Licensee claims on appeal that the ALJ made an error of law in concluding that Licensee failed to meet the requirement of section 102 of the Liquor Code as to the 400 square feet being accessible to the public.

The Pennsylvania State Police, Bureau of Liquor Control Enforcement ("BLCE") contends the legislative intent was to have 400 square feet of licensed premises available for use and accommodation of patrons. Section 102 says: "A restaurant is a reputable place having an area within a building of not less than 400 square feet, equipped with tables and chairs, accommodating at least 30 persons at one time." Member Negra requested that section be read again and it was.

Although somewhat ambiguous to this issue, the Board and BLCE have been interpreting section 102 for decades as meaning Licensee must have 400 square feet of licensed serving area. Parts like storage areas, bathrooms, and kitchen are not counted towards the 400 square feet as they are not open to serving the public. The Board formally adopted this policy at a public meeting in October 1991. This ensures that the premises is a *bona fide* restaurant principally used for the purpose of providing food to the public.

Initially, the licensed premises had 710 square feet of licensed serving area when licensed but now has only 150 square feet because Licensee modified the space. Hence, the Licensee is in violation of the Liquor Code and Chief Counsel's Office is recommending dismissal of the appeal and that the decision of the ALJ be affirmed.

Attorney Fox explained that this case and the next 12 cases are all out of Philadelphia in 2017. They are all “Stop-n-Gos,” were adjudicated by the same ALJ, and have the same defense attorney who filed timely appeals for violations of the 400-square-foot rule. Many had other violations also, but only the 400-square-foot rule decision is being challenged.

All the citations were sustained by the ALJ and given fines of various amounts, most of which have not been paid. In each of these cases, for the same reasons as in the previous matter, Chief Counsel recommends dismissing these appeals and affirming the decisions of the ALJ.
