PUBLIC MEETING – 11:00 A.M

CALL TO ORDER *Chairman Holden*

Board Secretary Michael Vigoda indicated that a quorum of the Board was present and Chairman Holden called the meeting to order.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

The Board has reserved 10 minutes for Public Comment on printed agenda items.

Mr. Anthony Brichta called in and stated that he represented a licensee that was up for renewal (Bureau of Licensing agenda item #21). He stated that he would like to comment on it, but wanted to know if now would be the proper time or should he wait until the specific agenda item came up. Chairman Tim Holden said that he could comment now and if he had more to add later, he could do that as well. With that, Mr. Brichta stated the following:

“May it please this Honorable Board. My name is Anthony Brichta and myself and Ted Zeller represent Orion Restaurant Group III, Inc.

This case involves the iconic Tally Ho Tavern which served steel workers and Lehigh University teachers and students since 1933 in busy south Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. Our client purchased the

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Tavern and its real estate in 2014, with the goal to rehabilitate the facility which had fallen into disrepair and questionable operations. While no excuse and unbeknownst to our client, a CLA from the prior owners was transferred to our client. In short order, our client received violations under that Conditional Licensing Agreement (CLA).

After a nonrenewal hearing back in 2016, our client executed a new CLA which modified some of the conditions but, most importantly, set to end the CLA effective April 30, 2020, and upon the Board's approval of its license for the 2020/2022 license period.

At the time the 2017 CLA was being considered by our client, the Bureau of Liquor and Control Enforcement conducted an underage, undercover, compliance check at the Tally Ho. Our client received a letter of compliance thanking it for adherence to responsible alcohol management practices in carding the underage officer. A follow-up records check was conducted, and our client provided all of the necessary documents for inspection. Neither visit by State Police gave our client notice that it was going to be cited and our client executed the new CLA on a date in between the two visits.

Despite our client's compliance, it received a two-count citation for failing to card the State Police supervisor which was with the underage, undercover minor and a failure to produce required records under the CLA. This citation was appealed to the Northampton County Court of Common Pleas and remains pending.

The licensee before you today has never committed any major violation or enhanced penalty under the liquor code. It has not received any citation for service to a minor, service of a visibly intoxicated person, gambling or COVID violations.

The Citation record relative to the renewal period will reveal citations which caused only a couple hundred dollars in fines at best and mostly related to technical record violations under the CLAs.

Although 2017's citation remains on appeal, the Borough of Licensing illegally placed our client's license into safekeeping earlier this year, and we had to petition the Commonwealth Court to enjoin the PLCB to restore our client's license and privileges. The Court sided with the Licensee and restored the client's license. The case, however, remains pending causing significant financial hardship upon our client who is still reeling from losses during COVID and the LCB's illegal closure of its establishment which added to our client's losses. Respectfully, this Licensee does not want to be in continued litigation with the PLCB and we submit that it is a waste of resources for this Honorable Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to continue to fight with this Licensee in the Commonwealth Court and over the renewal of this License.

Simply put, this licensee is not a nuisance bar and does not deserve to have its license taken away. We ask this Honorable Board to end the litigation and renew this license without conditions so that the licensee and PLCB can both move on. We thank you for the opportunity to make this statement."

Chairman Holden confirmed that it was on the agenda for this meeting and the Board would take Mr. Brichta's comments into consideration. He reiterated that if Mr. Brichta wanted to comment later, he would be welcome to do so.

There were no other commentators either in person or on the teleconference.

Board Member Mike Negra asked Executive Deputy Chief Counsel, Stacy Rineer for background on RC's Bar and Grill LLC and W.G. Restaurant Corp.

Ms. Rineer indicated that her statement would pertain to agenda items concerning RC's Bar and Grill and W.G. Restaurant Corp.

"RC's Bar & Grill LLC and W.G. Restaurant Corp. are two of four licensees whose multiple Covid-related citations were consolidated with a single ALJ adjudication and Order for each licensee. The parties had stipulated to the facts of each citation and the ALJ adopted that Stipulation as his Findings of Fact. On appeal, there is no allegation by the licensee that the ALJ's Findings of Fact were not supported by substantial evidence.

The ALJ concluded as a matter of law that the licensees violated the Governor's Executive Orders and mandates pertaining to Covid-mitigation measures, including but not limited to masking, social distancing, on-premises consumption of food and/or alcohol, and other operational limitations. The ALJ further concluded as a matter of law that the licensees had violated provisions of the Liquor Code, including but not limited to sections 462(a) and 471, by failing to comply with this Board's Advisory Notice No. 26 requiring compliance with the Governor's Covid restrictions. The ALJ ordered each licensee to pay a total of \$6,000 in fines and to serve 75 days of suspension.

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In their appeals to this Board, RC's Bar & Grill LLC, and W.G. Restaurant Corp. each set forth nine legal issues that may all be characterized as alleging either error of law or abuse of discretion by the ALJ. In summary, licensees contend that the Orders and mandates violate their constitutional rights and exceeded the Governor's emergency powers, rendering the citations invalid and unenforceable.

The Pennsylvania Supreme Court has ruled that only the judiciary, and not an administrative agency, may hear and address constitutional challenges such as those presented. Furthermore, this Board properly exercised its authority under the Liquor Code in its adoption of Advisory Notice No. 26. It is the opinion of the Chief Counsel that the ALJ did not commit any errors of law, nor did he abuse his discretion. The recommendation is that the Board affirm the ALJ's decision in each of the two cases and remand to the ALJ to set the license suspension dates and to ensure compliance with same."

The IES costs are allocated among Commonwealth departments based on each agency’s prior-year usage/activity of the various SAP modules: Payroll, Human Resources, Finance, Procurement, Budget and Plant Maintenance. The PLCB’s net billing represents 5.5% of the total \$32.1 million billed out for the Commonwealth’s costs for the SAP ERP system, which was an increase of \$320,453 (+22.0%) from FY 2020-21’s billing of \$1,453,681.

(2) Integrated Enterprise System (IES) Billing (Job 920–“true-up”) – The FY 2020-21 reconciliation billing (true-up) of \$142,439.50 is to reimburse the Executive Offices for the difference between the estimated and actual costs for the PLCB’s usage of the Commonwealth’s integrated ERP system (SAP) in FY 2020-21.
