Mr. Diaz offered that this is the final form of a regulatory change, and is identical to the proposed regulation that had been previously approved by the Board. After the Board approved the proposed regulation, it was published in the PA Bulletin for public comment. The only comment received was a "thank you" for making the changes. The changes to Chapter 5, subchapter B are not substantive but rather removing redundant sections and references to statutes that are no longer in existence. Should the Board approve the update, the regulation change will go to IRRC and because no changes were made, it will be deemed approved. The regulation will then go to the Attorney General one last time and then it will be published.
