Mr. Kida's specific questions pertained to transparency and consistency issues regarding the scheduling of a spring lottery, the availability of certain bourbons previously included in the lottery now being sold in some stores, the availability of certain allocated bourbons previously available online now available in stores and whether this will be a consistent practice, and concerns about the Board establishing safeguards to avoid excessive purchases of high demand products by individuals. Douglas Hitz, Deputy Executive Director, requested that Mr. Kida email his

inquiries to the Bureau of Communications' resource account for a comprehensive response, and Mr. Kida agreed to do so.
