Dear Mr. Shainis:

After evaluation of your proposal in response to RFP #OGC-2023-11 Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Counsel, by the Office of General Counsel ("OGC"), I hereby appoint your firm, Shainis & Peltzman, Chartered, the firm ("Firm") to represent the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State System, in the above-referenced matter. ## 1. <u>Information regarding the proposed engagement</u>

The purpose of this appointment is for the Firm to satisfy a need for legal counsel to provide guidance regarding application of laws and regulations on matters pertaining to the FCC.

## 2. <u>Scope of Services</u>

In this appointment, the Firm will represent the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, specifically the State System, with respect to all matters pertaining to the FCC for the Commonwealth-owned universities and the Office of the Chancellor. Duties and responsibilities include, but in no way are limited to the following:

- (1) Advice and assistance regarding radio station license renewals.
- (2) Advice and assistance regarding FCC regulatory compliance issues.
- (3) Advice and assistance regarding filing of applications for noncommercial radio station licenses.
- (4) Representing universities and/or the State System in the areas outlined above, and related matters, before the relevant agencies and tribunals.

The Firm may at any time, be called upon to provide specific services to the State System based on specific need, capacity, qualification, or such other circumstances as the State System shall determine. This engagement may include other general work as designated by the Chief Counsel of the State System or the Governor's Office of General Counsel.

## 3. Compensation

It is agreed upon by the Firm and all parties to this agreement consistent with its proposal for this engagement that the Firm shall be paid at the following rates: all attorneys will be billed at \$350.00 per hour.

Kiessling at acknowledging that the Firm has completed a conflict-of-interest analysis and identified nothing to be reported prior to the acceptance of work on behalf of the Governor's Office of General Counsel. Should a conflict or potential conflict be identified at any time during the term of this engagement, the Firm is under a continuing obligation to disclose such matter, in writing, to the Governor's Office of General Counsel in accordance with OGC's Conflict Waiver Procedure. Failure to sign and return your Firm's appointment letter within thirty (30) days will result in your Firm being dropped from this engagement.
