Holmes, LLC, Sand & Saidel, PC, Ahmad Zaffarese, LLC, Berman Voss, and their respective subcontractors required to be disclosed or approved by the Commonwealth have been verified as responsible contractors in accordance with management directives, the Procurement Handbook and the Procurement Code, as applicable.

PART IV.

RECOMMENDATION: As the Issuing Officer, I recommend Goldfein & Joseph, P.C., Rulis & Bochicchio, LLC, the Law Office of Nathaniel M. Holmes, LLC, Sand & Saidel, PC, Ahmad Zaffarese, LLC and Berman Voss be awarded contracts for legal services. This recommendation selection is based upon the results of the evaluation and review of the proposals as summarized above. The term of the contracts will be two (2) years with three (3) additional one (1) year renewals.
