1. Information regarding the proposed engagement

2. <u>Scope of Services</u>

The Firm shall represent the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting by and through the General Counsel, her designee or OB, in matters relating generally to tax advice, financing advice and general legal advice and counsel.

The Firm shall make itself available, from time-to-time and at the sole discretion of the General Counsel or her designee, to advise and counsel the Commonwealth on general tax advice, financing advice, and general legal advice and counsel regarding the use of the tax-exempt proceeds of General Obligation bonds or the use of revenue bond proceeds issued by the Commonwealth or its authorities; excluding, however, advice and counsel regarding (i) the issuance of any General Obligation bond series of general obligation bonds or (ii) bond disclosure counsel.

The types of services include but are not limited to advice on matters related to:

- a) Capital budget process as it relates to expenditures of bond proceeds;
- b) The acceptance, expenditure use, handling of bond proceeds and Commonwealth general bond issuances or the proceeds of revenue bonds; and
- c) Matters involving Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code.

The General Counsel reserves the right to make any assignment as she may deem necessary or desirable, in her judgment, for all aspects of, or roles within the scope of, this RFP.

3. Compensation

It is agreed upon by the Firm and all parties to this agreement consistent with its proposal for this engagement that the Firm shall be paid at the following rates: Partners will be billed at a rate of \$425.00 per hour; Associates will be billed at a rate of \$225.00 per hour; Paralegals will be billed at a rate of \$125.00 per hour.
