- PowerPoint (or other visually projected material)
- Lesson Plan (candidate developed or an existing plan). The following are normal plan items:
  - Lesson Name
  - Lesson Goal or Overview
  - Learning Objectives (to include behavior, condition, and degree)
  - Time (estimated)
  - Instructional Materials / Audiovisuals / Props / Equipment
  - Delivery Format (e.g., Lecture, Demonstration, Simulator use, etc.)
  - Setting (classroom, apparatus floor, training tower, etc.)
  - References (all materials used in creating the lesson)
  - Lesson Outline and Content
    - Introduction
    - Instructional Content
    - Summary
  - Activities
  - Evaluation Tools (e.g., quiz with answer sheet, skill evaluation sheet, etc.)
- Props, simulation or technical support aids, equipment, or other cognitive or psychomotor instructional aids (i.e., informational sheets, activity sheets, etc.). [*Note: These should be listed in the Instructional materials section of the lesson plan.*]
