

A BOOST for Pennsylvania Youth

PCCD's Building Opportunity through Out-of-School Time (BOOST) grants expand out-of-school time structured programming for at-risk school-age youth.



Why is it Important?

- Demand far exceeds availability— for every child enrolled in an afterschool program, 4 more were waiting for a spot.
- Afterschool and out-of-school-time programs yield a \$7 return for every \$1 invested, providing high-impact opportunities for youth development and violence prevention.

Program Funding

Last Year **\$11.5M**

25-26 Proposed **\$21.5M**

Why the Increase?

PCCD received overwhelming response to the first BOOST grant cycle with nearly **300 applications** requesting **6x the available funding.**
