## 40<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

As we look to another year of training, it's of note that the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Education and Training Board and its programs were created 40 years ago in 1984. During that time, the Board has provided certification training for over 7,500 sheriffs and deputies through 97 basic and 117 waiver classes.

## 2025 SHERIFF AND DEPUTY SHERIFF BASIC TRAINING

The Basic Training schedule for 2025 is provided below. To be in compliance with 44 Pa.C.S. §7428 (relating to deputy sheriff training requirement), any deputy hired by the sheriff has one year in which to complete his or her training and be certified by the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Education and Training Board (SDSETB). In addition, newly elected or appointed sheriffs are required to complete certification training in accordance with the Training Act.

Sheriffs are required to utilize the on-line enrollment process available through the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Information System (SDSIS). Accessing the SDSIS will assist your office in the management of your training needs and requirements. You will have instant access to your deputies training records and the ability to monitor their training status. The SDSIS web address is <https://www.pccddsis.pa.gov>.

Deputies must hold current certification in First Aid and CPR prior to enrollment in the Basic Training Academy. Documentation must be uploaded into the SDSIS. Nationally recognized training/certification will be accepted.

In addition, sheriffs and deputies that attend the Basic Training Academy are required to complete additional on-line training courses for certification. The required courses include:

1. Introduction to Incident Command for Law Enforcement (IS-100LE), offered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), registration available at <https://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-100.c>.
2. National Incident Command (IS-700), offered by FEMA, registration available at <http://training.fema.gov/EMIWeb/IS/is700a.asp>.
3. Cultural Diversity and All Hazards (Module 1 – Hazmat/WMD Awareness and Module 2 – Security Threat Groups), SDSETB sponsored and offered by Temple University, through Temple's Canvas Learning Management System

To access the on-line training courses offered by Temple University, sheriffs and deputies are required to create their own individual user access to the SDSIS. The SDSIS Login User Guide can be found here:

After creating access to the SDSIS, PCCD will authorize Temple University to enroll the sheriff or deputy in the online training course(s). Temple University will send an email to each sheriff and deputy with instructions to access the online training.

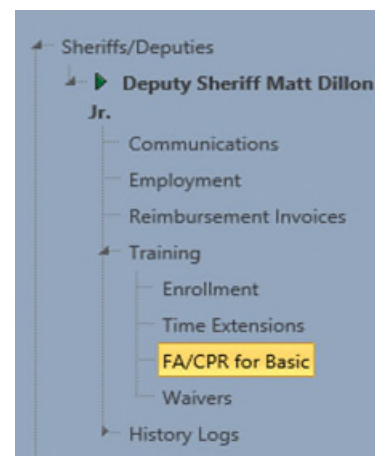
**2025 Basic Training Courses**

B-25-01	January 6, 2025 – May 16, 2025	Penn State, University Park
B-25-02	April 14, 2025 – August 22, 2025	Penn State, University Park
B-25-03	July 14, 2025 – November 21, 2025	Penn State, University Park

**NOTE: All scheduled classes have a minimum enrollment requirement of 27 sheriffs and/or deputies. If the minimum enrollment is not met within 30 days of the class start date, the class will be cancelled, and all enrollees will be moved to the next basic training class. Class B-25-02 will NOT be available for enrollment until after the entrance fitness test for B-25-01 is completed. Class B-25-03 will NOT be available for enrollment until after the entrance fitness test for B-25-02 is completed.**

County administrators are required to upload current first aid and CPR certifications into the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Information System (SDSIS) for the student to be eligible for enrollment in basic training. If the documents are not uploaded the student will not appear in the enrollment field as eligible.

Certification documents can be uploaded by selecting the “FA/CPR for Basic” Tab on the left panel of the individual students SDSIS page. This is somewhat different from the Waiver Training requirement and does not require staff approval prior to allowing enrollment.



Once selected, the tab will take you to a screen where you can upload the required certifications. Once those documents are added, the student will be eligible for enrollment in a Basic Training Academy class.
