FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, COMMISSION'S DECISION AND FINAL ORDER

- Complainant herein is Grace E. Martin, who resides at 7122 Hermitage Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15208.
- Respondent herein is Ibraheen Ghafoor, who resides at 6800 Frankstown Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15208.
- Complainant was hired by the Respondent in July, 1971, to work with Mr. Austin, who was then Assistant Property Manager of Respondent's real estate company. (T.8, 25)
- When Mr. Austin was fired, Complainant was asked to instruct the new Assistant Property Manager, Mr. Blasia. (T. 10, 47)
- One week after Mr. Blasia was hired, Complainant told Respondent that she did not want to teach Mr. Blasia because he was making so much more money than she. (T. 19)
- 6. At the time of this colloquy, Complainant was being paid \$90.00 per week and Mr. Blasia was being paid \$100.00 per week. (T. 41-42)
- Complainant subsequently had several heated discussions 7. with Mr. Blasia in the presence of others. (T. 14)
- Respondent had a problem with Complainant's coming to .work late, and leaving work early. (T. 43, 50)

- 9. Respondent also had complaints from customers concerning Complainant. (T. 43-44, 78)
- 10. A customer, Ruby Upshaw, testified that Complainant assumed a very nasty attitude towards her. (T. 74)
- 11. Complainant's co-worker, Audrey Harris, testified that Complainant had a snappy attitude and resented taking orders. (T. 64)
- 12. Respondent had several discussions with Complainant about correcting her attitude. (T. 60)
- 13. Respondent finally dismissed Complainant on November 12, 1971. (T. 11)

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon all the evidence at the Public Hearing, and upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission makes the following Conclusions of Law:

- 1. The Complaint and the Amended Complaint were properly filed by the Complainant, Grace E. Martin.
- 2. At all times mentioned herein, the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission had jurisdiction over the Respondent and the subject matter of the Complaint.
- 3. The terms of employment involving the Complainant and the Complainant's subsequent discharge were not sexually discriminatory actions in violation of Section 5 (a) of the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act.

IT IS, therefore, recommended that the Commission enter an Order dismissing the Complaint against the Respondent, Ibraheen Ghafoor.
