


VISION

PENNSYLVANIA LAW PROHIBITS
DISCRIMINATION BASED ON PROTECTED



Race, Color, Religious Creed, Ancestry, Age (40 and over), Sex, National Origin, Familial Status (only in housing), Handicap or Disability and the use, handling or training of support or guide animals for disability, Retaliation for filing a complaint of unlawful discrimination, opposing unlawful discrimination, or assisting with an investigation into unlawful discriminatory behavior is also illegal.

EXAMPLES OF DISCRIMINATION:









- Firing or demoting someone based solely on his/her/their protected class(es).
- Denying a student with a disability the use of a service animal.
- Firing a woman just because she is pregnant.
- Creating school policies that could provide different treatment for students based on their protected class(es).
