Chairman Vogler called the meeting to order at 9:15 A.M. at the PSBA Headquarters in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania. The Chairman expressed appreciation to PSBA for hosting the Board's September meeting and dinner.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES AND GUIDELINES

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Mr. Grossman presented proposed changes to the Investment Policy Statement, Objectives and Guidelines.

Ms. Langan moved that the Public School Employees' Retirement Board (the "Board") adopt proposed changes to Exhibits B, C, D and E of the Investment Policy Statement, Objectives, and Guidelines, as amended, for the Public School Employees' Retirement System pursuant to the recommendation of James H. Grossman, Jr., Chief Investment Officer, dated August 19, 2016. Ms. Keaveney seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
