Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on Bushkill Falls Rd at its intersection with Old Shohola Rd, Lehman Twp, Pike County. Unit 1 was traveling southbound when it failed to negotiate a sharp and downward right curve in the roadway. Unit 1 subsequently traveled across the northbound lane and struck a small ditch on the left side of the road which caused Unit 1 to overturn and come to final rest on its roof. Operator 1 sustained a suspected minor injury to his hand as a result of this crash. Unit 1 sustained moderate damage all around as a result of this crash.

Crash Synopsis:

Prior to this crash, Operator #1 was attempting to park Unit #1 in a parking stall in the public parking lot located at 103 Nichercronk Rd in Delaware Township, Pike County. Operator #1 drove unit #1 east attempting to park the vehicle in a parking stall. Operator #1 intended to apply the brakes of the vehicle but unintentionally pressed the accelerator. Operator #1 lost control of unit #1. Unit #1 traveled east over a parking curb. The vehicle continued over the curb and east down a small embankment until the vehicle entered PA 739. Unit #1 traveled south on PA 739 for a very short distance until the vehicle entered the embankment on the west shoulder of the road again. The passenger side of Unit #1 swiped a metal utility pole. There was no damage observed to the pole. Unit#1 came to final rest facing southwest on the embankment of PA 739 with damage to the front passenger side bumper, rear driver's side door, rear drivers side quarter panel, and rear bumper. No injuries were reported. Operator #1 was issued a notice of the crash investigation. Unit #1 was towed from the scene by Automarx towing.
