**This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling south directly behind Unit 2 on Interstate 81 near mile-marker 14 in Guilford Twp., Franklin County. As Unit 2 began to slow down, the 12 O'Clock position of Unit 1 struck the 6 O'Clock position of Unit 2. This was the initial point of impact. Unit 1 sustained disabling front end damage and came to a final uncontrolled rest in the right travel lane of I-81S. Unit 2 did not stop and continued southbound on I-81. Operator 1 and Passenger 1 sustained suspected minor injury and were transported to Chambersburg Hospital by Wellspan EMS. Unit 1 was towed from the scene by CDC Towing.**

**Operator 1 was subsequently cited for VC 3310 - Following Too Closely.**

**Crash Synopsis:**

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling west on Orrstown Rd near its intersection with Municipal Dr. in Southampton Twp., Franklin County. For an unknown reason, Unit 1 veered across the oncoming eastbound lane and subsequently left the roadway. Unit 1 then struck a utility pole to the south side of the roadway at the 11 O'clock position. This was the initial point of impact. Unit 1 then continued west through the grass to the south of Orrstown Rd before coming to an uncontrolled rest facing west approximately 50 yards west of the point of impact. Operator 1 fled from the scene on foot prior to State Police arrival. Unit 1 sustained disabling damage and was towed from the scene by Robinson's Towing.

Operator 1 was later interviewed and admitted to consuming a large quantity of alcohol immediately prior to the crash. Operator 1 was subsequently charged with driving under the influence of alcohol and related traffic offenses.

**Crash Synopsis:**

This single vehicle crash occurred at the on-ramp of I-81 S MM5. On 02/03/2025 Unit 1 was traveling westbound on SR0016 and was attempting a left and turn onto the I-81 S MM5 on-ramp. As Unit 1 was attempting the turn it was traveling too fast and was unable to complete the turn. Unit 1 then struck a PENNDOT sign before going over the edge of a small hill, coming to a final controlled rest. Unit 1 was able to reverse out of the hill under its own power, however sustained disabling damage at some point during its operation to its 1 O'clock position. Operator 1 advised that he was uninjured. Unit 1 was removed from the scene by CUNNINGHAM's Towing.

**This crash occurred as Unit 1 was attempting to turn left onto United Drive, Southampton Township, Franklin County PA from the entrance to the Amazon Warehouse after stopping at a properly posted stop sign. Unit 2 was traveling east on United Drive. Unit 1 began turning left on United Drive and struck the 9 o'clock position of Unit 2 with its 1 o'clock position.
