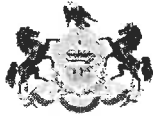

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on 08/19/2024 at approximately 1125 hours. Unit #2 was traveling southbound on SR 209 approaching its intersection with Maple St in Washington Township, Dauphin County. Unit #1, towing a utility trailer, was traveling directly behind Unit #2. Unit #2 proceeded to slow down and attempt to stop due to a vehicle in front of it stopping at the intersection, yielding to turn left. Unit #1 failed to stop and rear-ended Unit #2. Unit #1 sustained minor damage and the operator was uninjured. Unit #2 sustained disabling damage and the operator and passenger both sustained suspected minor injuries. Unit #1 was able to leave the scene of the crash under its own power. Unit #2 was towed from the scene by Peifer's towing. Operator and passenger for Unit #2 were assessed by EMS on scene and the refused medical transport by EMS personnel but were traveling to the hospital privately for further assessment. The southbound lane of SR 209 was closed and reopened at approximately 1210 hours as a result of this crash.

This crash occurred on 08/16/2024, at approximately 1433 hours, on Gold Mind Rd and State Route 1001, Rush Township, Dauphin County. Before the crash, Unit 1 was in the single lane highway going Northbound on Gold Mind Rd and State Route 1001 and Unit 2 was in the single lane highway going Southbound on Gold Mind Rd and State Route 1001. At the time of the crash, Unit 1 passed Witness 1 in a no pass zone, entered back into his lane of travel, but could not maintain speed and hit Unit 2 at the front driver side door. After initial impact, Operator 1 stayed at final rest in the middle of the roadway and Unit 2 stayed in the single lane still heading Southbound on Gold Mind Rd and State Route 1001. Operator 1 was transported by Tower Porter EMS to Bendigo airport and life flighted to Hershey Medical Hospital.
